
Before Jesus died, He was put on trial.




Peter stood outside the trial.




A girl looked at Peter and said Peter was one of Jesus's disciples.




Peter said he did not know Jesus.




A little later, another person said that Peter was one of Jesus's disciples.



Peter said he was not Jesus's disciple.




An hour later, someone else said Peter was one of Jesus's disciples.




Peter said he was not. Then the rooster crowed. It happened just like Jesus said it would.




Peter ran away and wept. His heart was broken.



After Jesus died and came back to life, He asked Peter 3 times if Peter loved Him. Peter said, "yes" each time.




Jesus asked Peter to feed His lambs, the people who believe in Him.
