Jeremiah was God's prophet. A prophet is a person who speaks for God. He had a very hard job to do. He had to tell people about their sin.



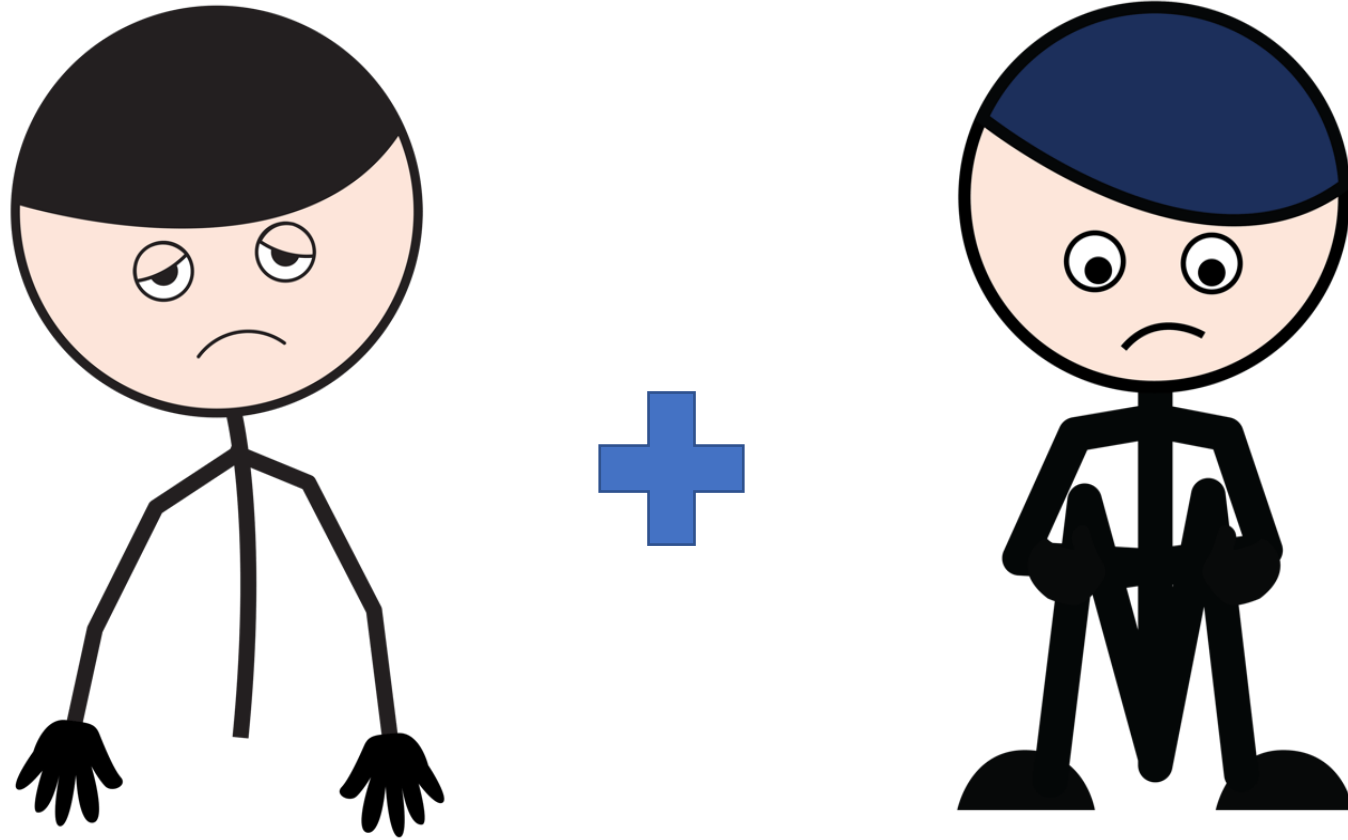
Jeremiah warned the people for 40 years that if they did not stop sinning, God would punish them and give them the consequences they deserved.



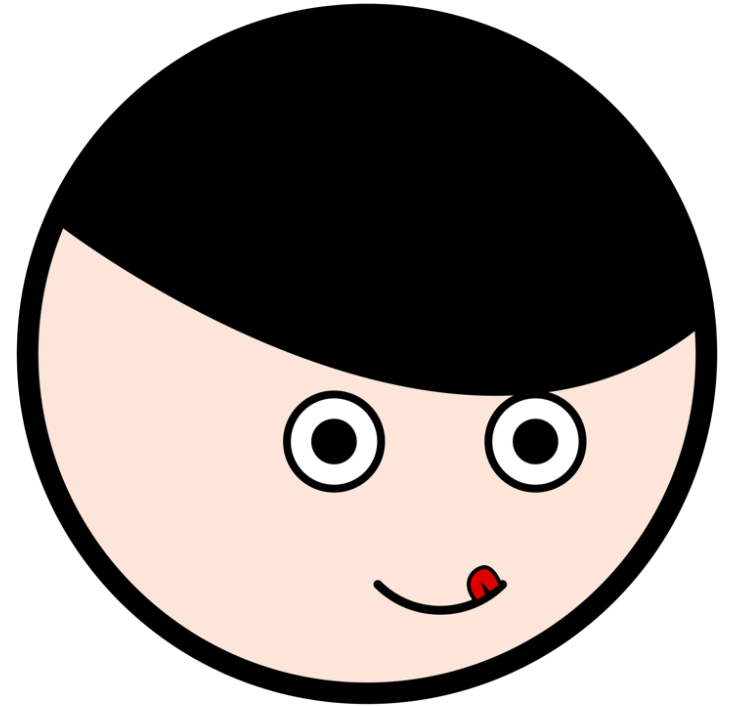
The people did not listen. They kept on sinning.



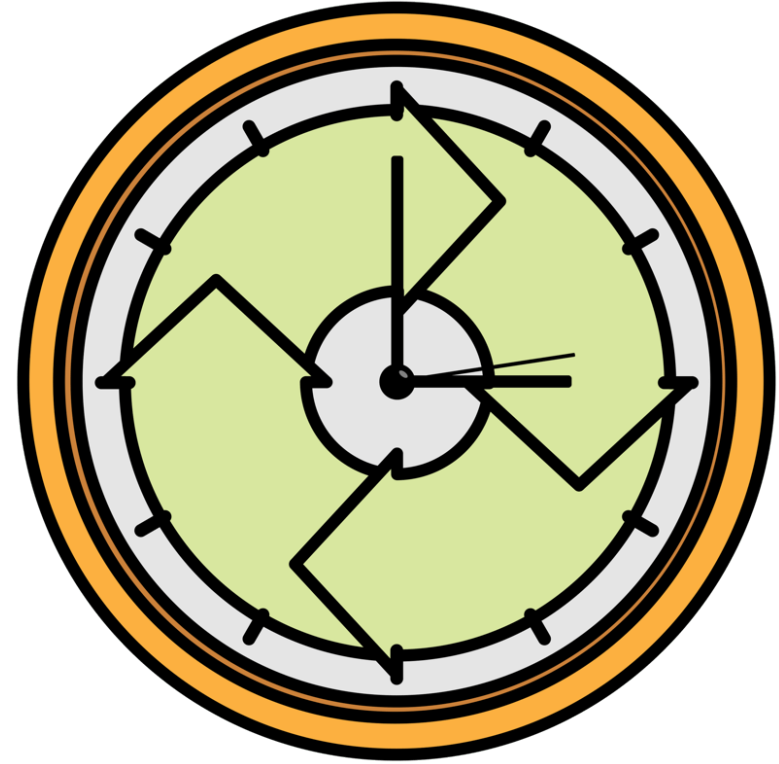
In the end, their city was burned, and the people were taken prisoner, just like God promised.



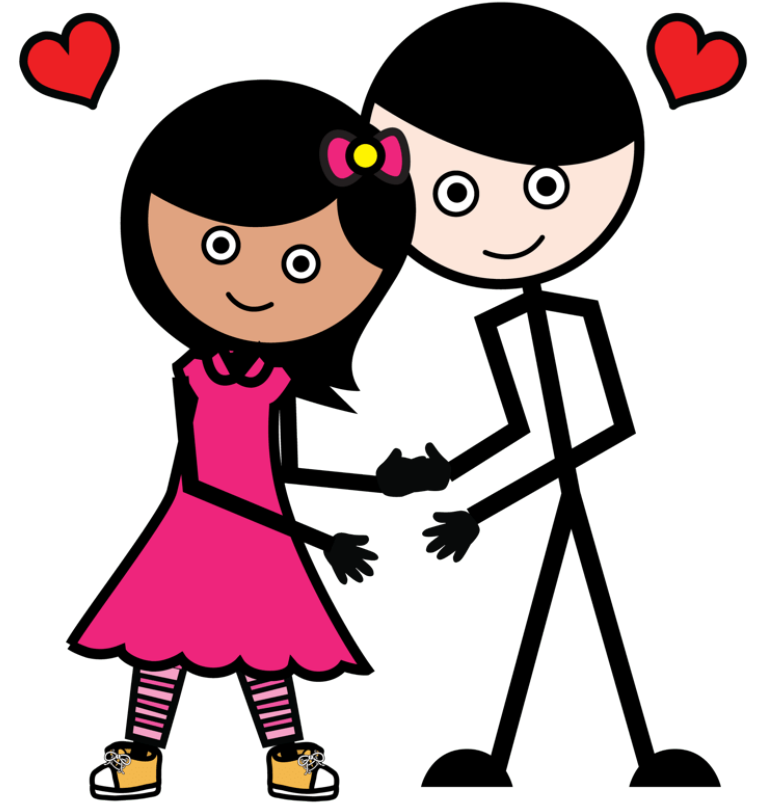
