The Road to Damascus

UNIT: Early Church

UNIT MEMORY VERSE:

"Give thanks to the Lord for He is good; His love endures forever." PSALM 107:1

TEACHING TRUTH:

Jesus has the power to change lives

READ: ACTS 9:1-20

OPTIONAL: "A Changed Man" (pages 488-493) from [The Beginner's Bible](#)

WHAT DOES IT SAY? (OBSERVATION)

1. Was Saul kind to Jesus' followers? (*No, he was not kind. He was mean and wanted to put them in prison.*)
2. What happened to Saul when he was walking on the road to Damascus? (*A bright light shone around him. He was blinded and could not see. Jesus talked to him.*)
3. What special job did God have for Saul to do? (*God was going to use him to tell others the good news about Jesus.*)

WHY DOES IT MATTER? (APPLICATION)

1. Saul was really mean to Jesus' followers, but after He met Jesus, his entire life changed! How did this happen? (*God changed his heart so that he did not want to be mean to Jesus' followers anymore. He wanted to follow Jesus instead.*)
2. What do you think God wants us to learn from this story? (*Let your kids answer and then bring them back to this week's teaching truth: Jesus has the power to change lives.*)
3. Pray a short simple prayer thanking Jesus that He has the power to change lives.
