DEFINITION:

Consistently working with all my heart to bring glory to God

MEMORY VERSE:

"So, my dear brothers and sisters, be strong and immovable. Always work enthusiastically for the Lord, for you know that nothing you do for the Lord is ever useless." 1 CORINTHIANS 15:58

FINISH LINE:

God gives us what we need to do His work

READ: ACTS 1:8; 2:1-12, 41; 2 PETER 1:3

WHAT DOES IT SAY?

(OBSERVATION)

- What gift was Jesus going to give after He returned to heaven? (The Holy Spirit)
- Read Acts 1:8. What were the disciples supposed to do after they received the Holy Spirit? (Tell others about Jesus in Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and the rest of the world.)
- Which locations are mentioned in Acts 2:8-11? Google "Pentecost map" and look at where all of the visitors to Jerusalem came from.
- 4. What did the visitors do when they heard the believers speaking in their languages? (They were amazed and wanted to know what was going on.)
- 5. Look at verse 2:41. How many people were saved by putting their trust in Jesus as their Savior? (About 3,000!)

WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

(INTERPRETATION)

- 1. Did Jesus expect or even want the disciples to do the work on their own? (No. That is why God was going to send them the gift of the Holy Spirit.)
- 2. How did the Holy Spirit give
 Peter what he needed to be
 diligent in the work Jesus called
 him to do? (The Holy Spirit gave
 Peter the right words to say, the
 ability to speak to people in their
 own language, and the courage
 to boldly share about Jesus.)
- 3. What do you think these new believers did when they went back to their own homes? (Many told their friends and family what they heard from the believers about Jesus.)

WHY DOES IT MATTER?

(APPLICATION)

- 1. Second Peter 1:3 tells us that God has given us everything we need for living a godly life. What are some ways you can live a godly life? (Examples: Obey your parents, love your brothers and sisters, share the Gospel, encourage others, etc.)
- 2. How can God help you do His work? (He can give us patience when we are with others, self-control to obey our parents, and even the words to say when we are sharing the Gospel. God want to help us when we ask.)
