


We Can Be Content Because God is in Control





Contentment Contentment is being satisfied with God.




Saul was Israel's first king, and he had a son named Jonathan.




Usually, the oldest son became the next king, but God said no to Jonathan because Saul did not obey God.




God choose David to be the next king because David loved God.




This made King Saul so furious that he wanted to kill David.



David had to run away and hide from King Saul.




Jonathan and David were best friends. Jonathan trusted God's way was best and promised to protect David.




One day when David was hiding, Jonathan went to find him to ask how he could help David. David asked Jonathan to find out if King Saul was still angry. David wanted to come home.




Jonathan tried to talk to his father, but King Saul was still so angry. King Saul tried to hurt Jonathan, his own son!




Jonathan helped David run away again. They promised to always love each other and take care of each other's families no matter what happened.




David wrote a song about this time in his life.



David looked to God to keep him safe.




David cried out to God for help.







David's enemies tried to trap him, but he trusted in God.





