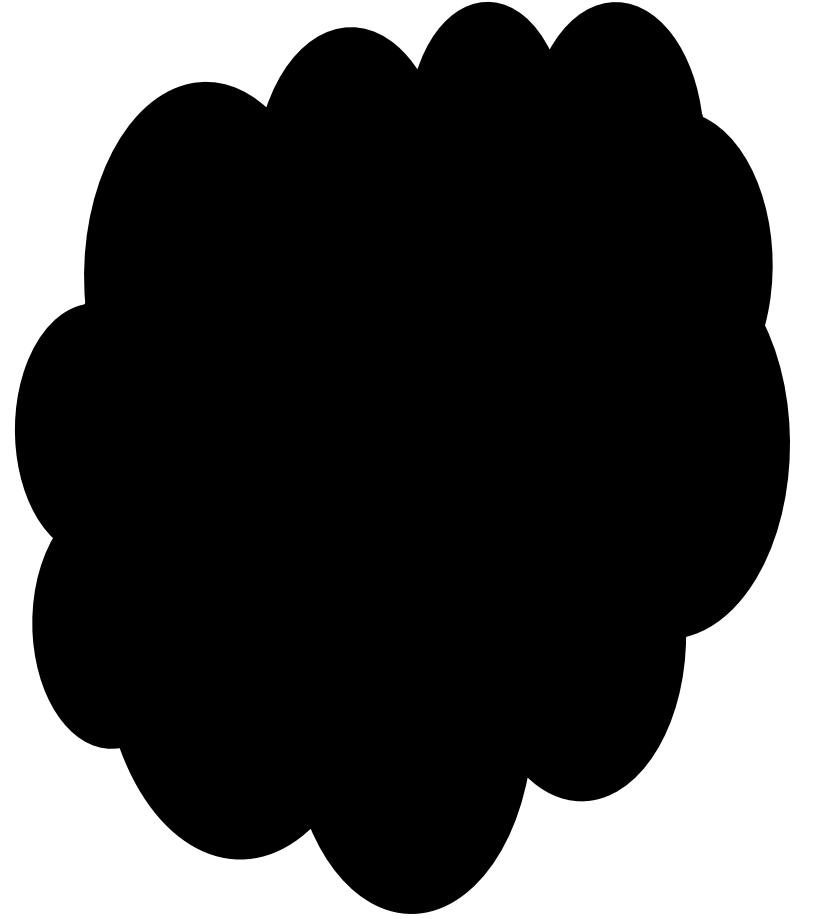
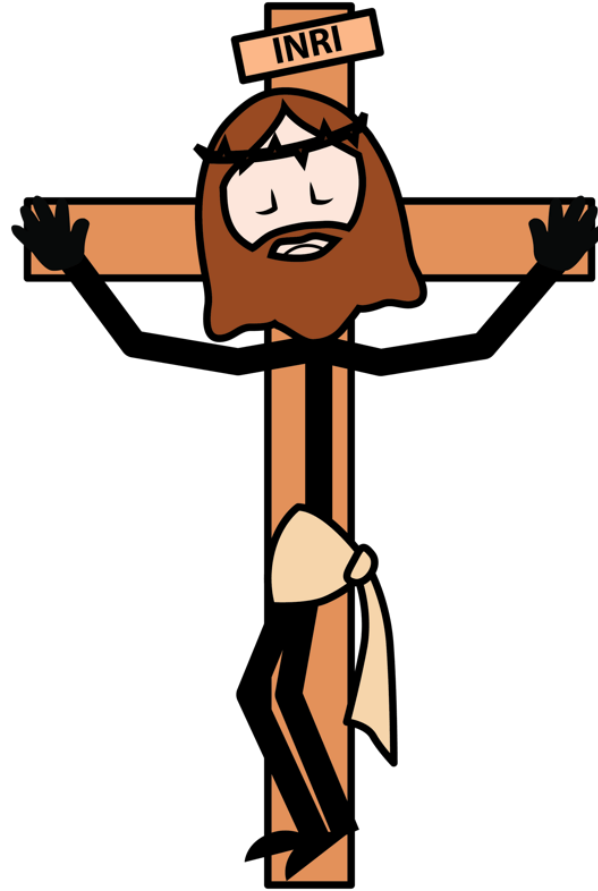
Sin is anything we think, say, or do that does not please God.



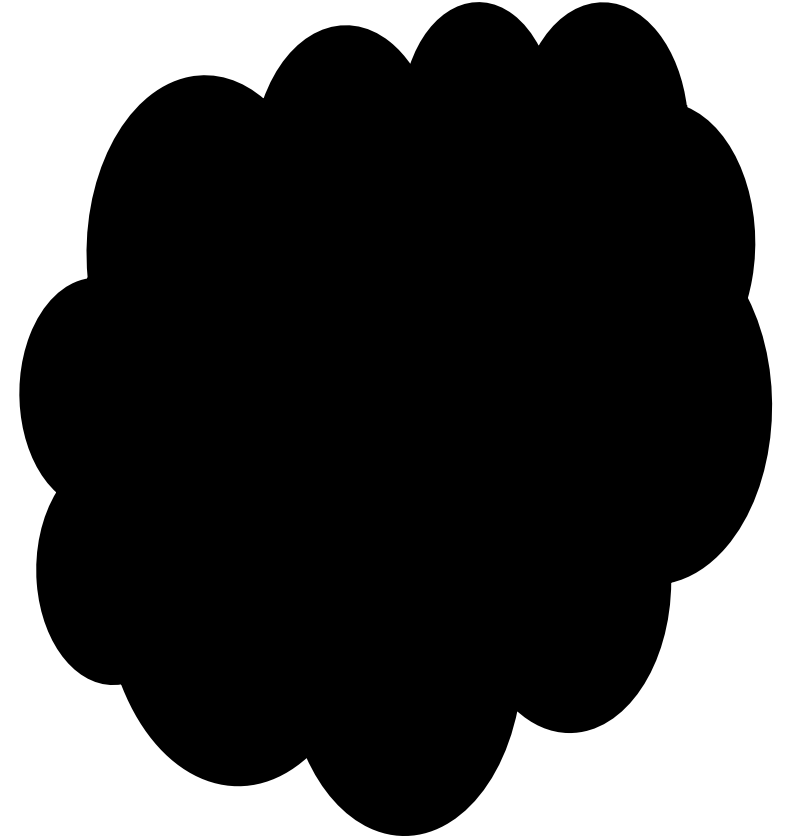
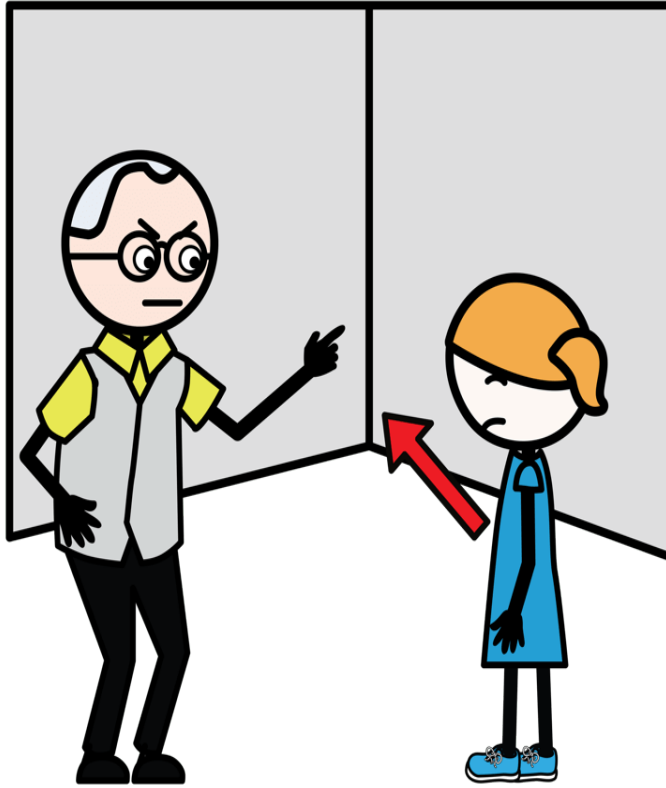
Sin separates us from God.



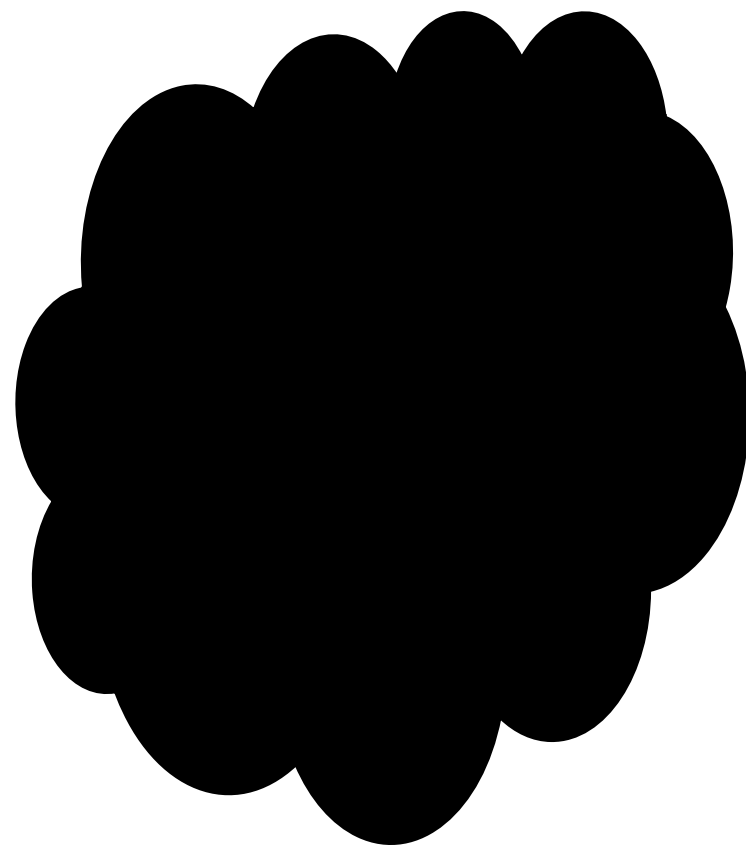
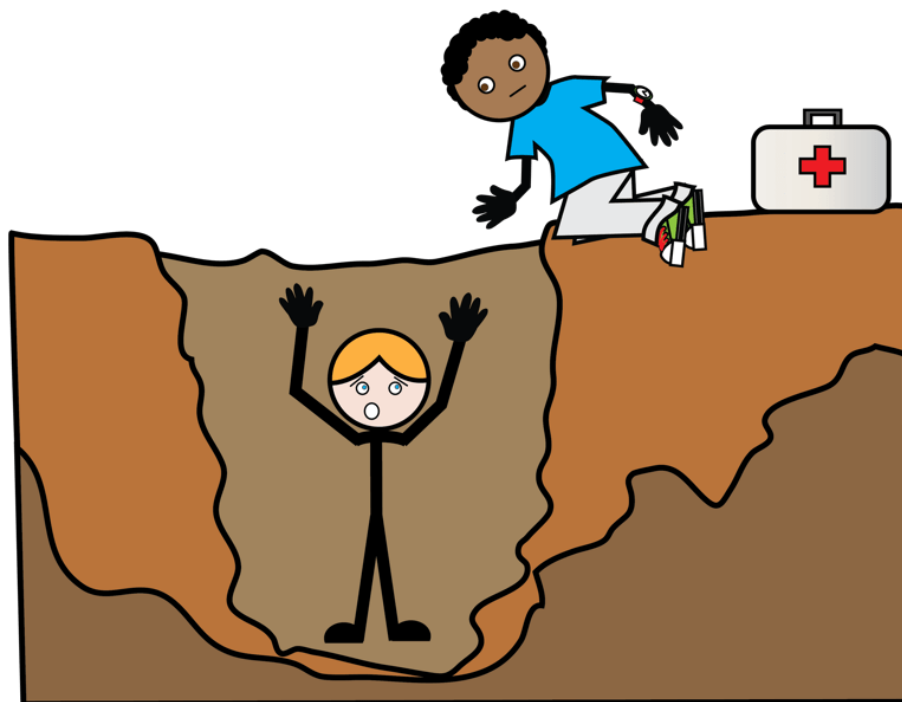
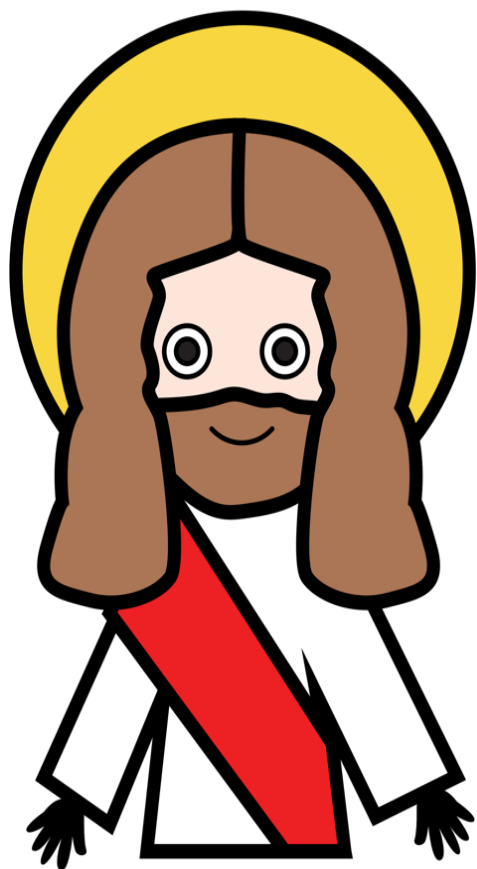

But God sent Jesus to die for our sin.



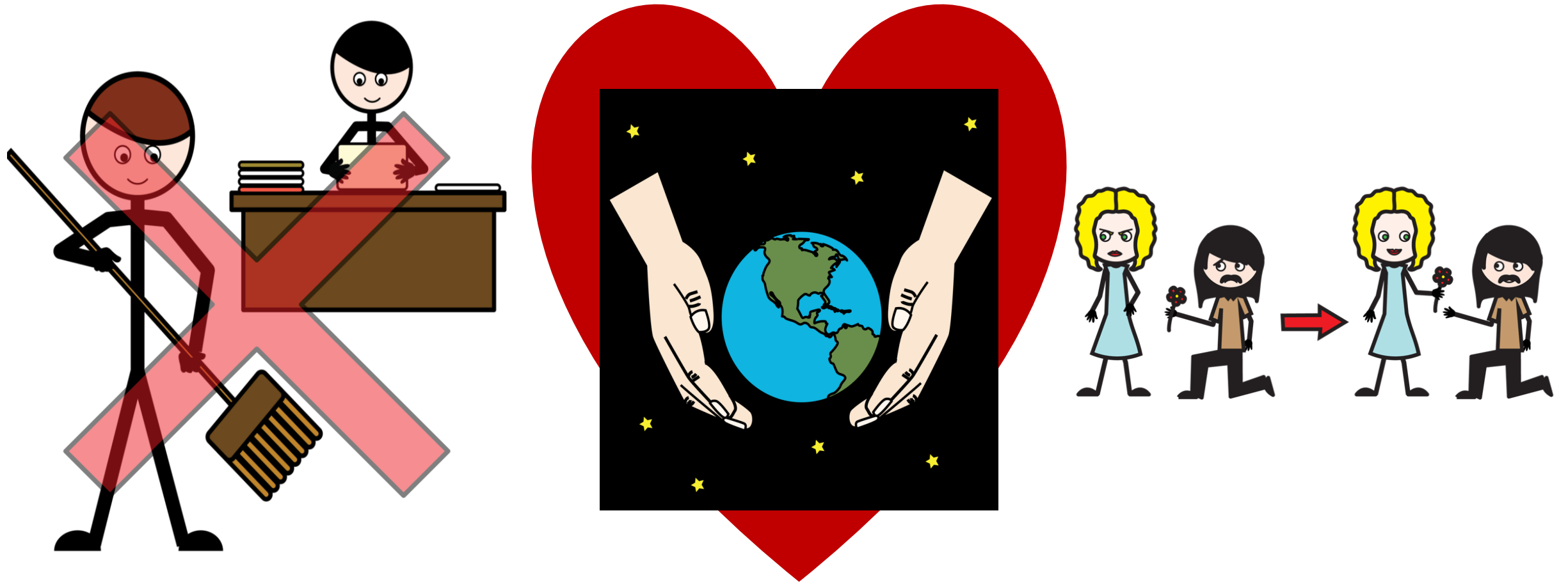

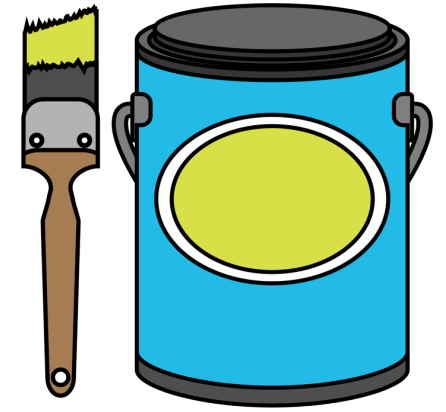
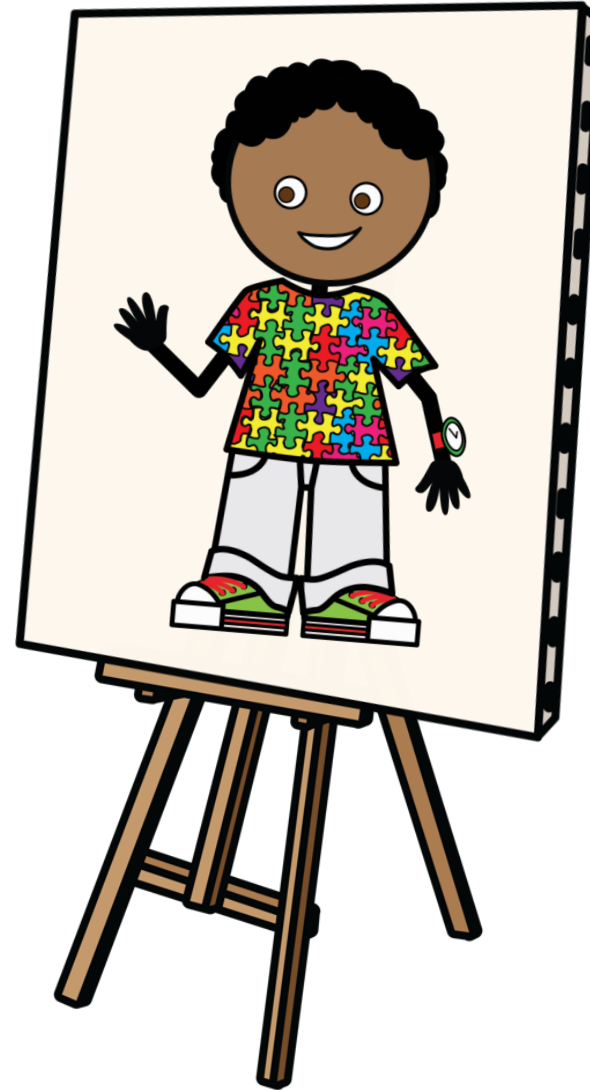
Salvation is a gift that God gives us.



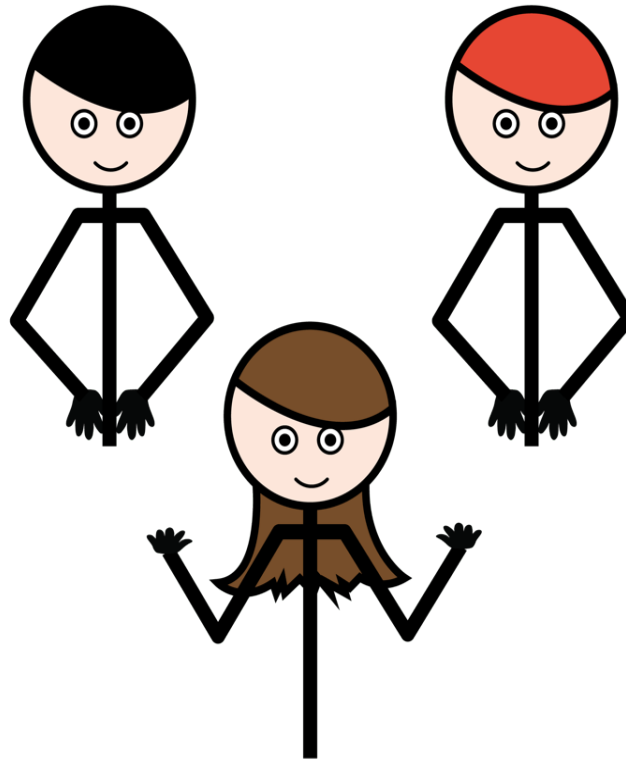
