THIS WEEK'S STORY:

Isaiah

UNIT: Christmas

UNIT MEMORY VERSE:

"For God loved the world so much that He gave His one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him will not perish but have eternal life." **John 3:16**

TEACHING TRUTH:

God promised to send a Savior

READ: Isaiah 9:1-7, Isaiah 53

OPTIONAL: "Operation No More Tears" (pages 144-151) from [The Jesus Storybook Bible](#)

WHAT DOES IT SAY? (OBSERVATION)

1. What was Isaiah's job? *(To listen to God's message and then tell the people what God told him to say)*
2. What message did Isaiah share with the people? *(That God promised to send a Savior to save them from their sins.)*
3. What did God promise the Savior would do? *(He would be a King and rescue His people.)*

WHY DOES IT MATTER? (APPLICATION)

1. Who is this promised Savior? *(It is Jesus!)*
2. Isaiah shared God's promises with others. Who can we share God's promises with? *(We can tell our family, friends, neighbors, and everyone we know about the good news of Jesus!)*
3. What do you think God wants us to learn from this story? *(Let your kids answer and then bring them back to this week's Teaching Truth: God promised to send a Savior.)*
4. Pray a short, simple prayer thanking God that He promised to send a Savior to rescue us.
