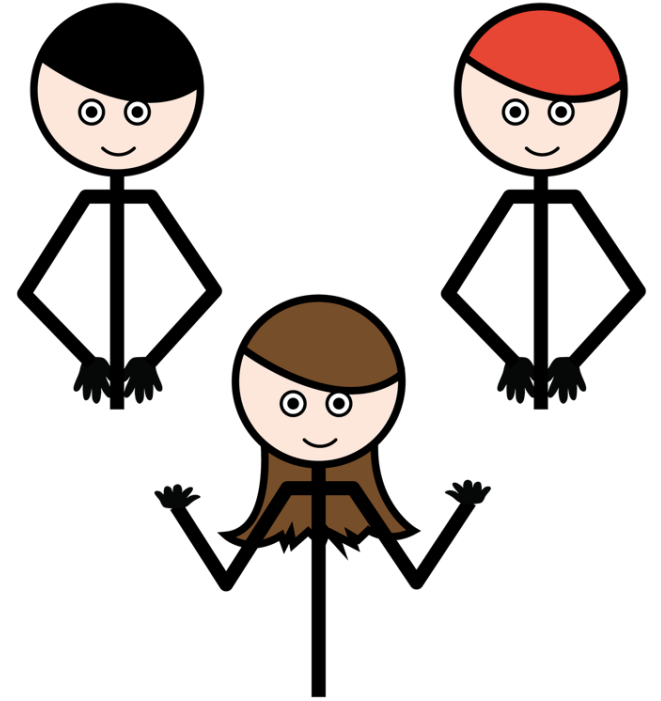




This Week's Story: God Calls Moses



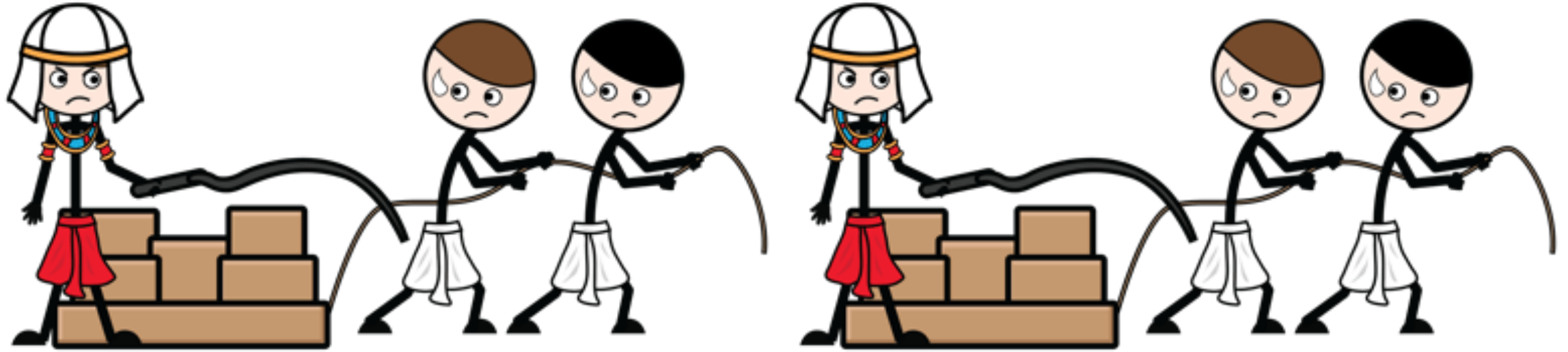
**Teaching Truth:
God is always with us**



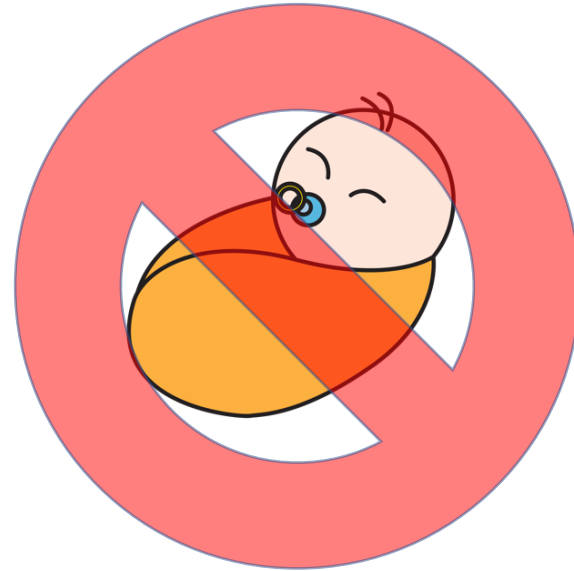
**After Joseph died, a new Pharaoh came to power.
This Pharaoh did not remember Joseph at all.**



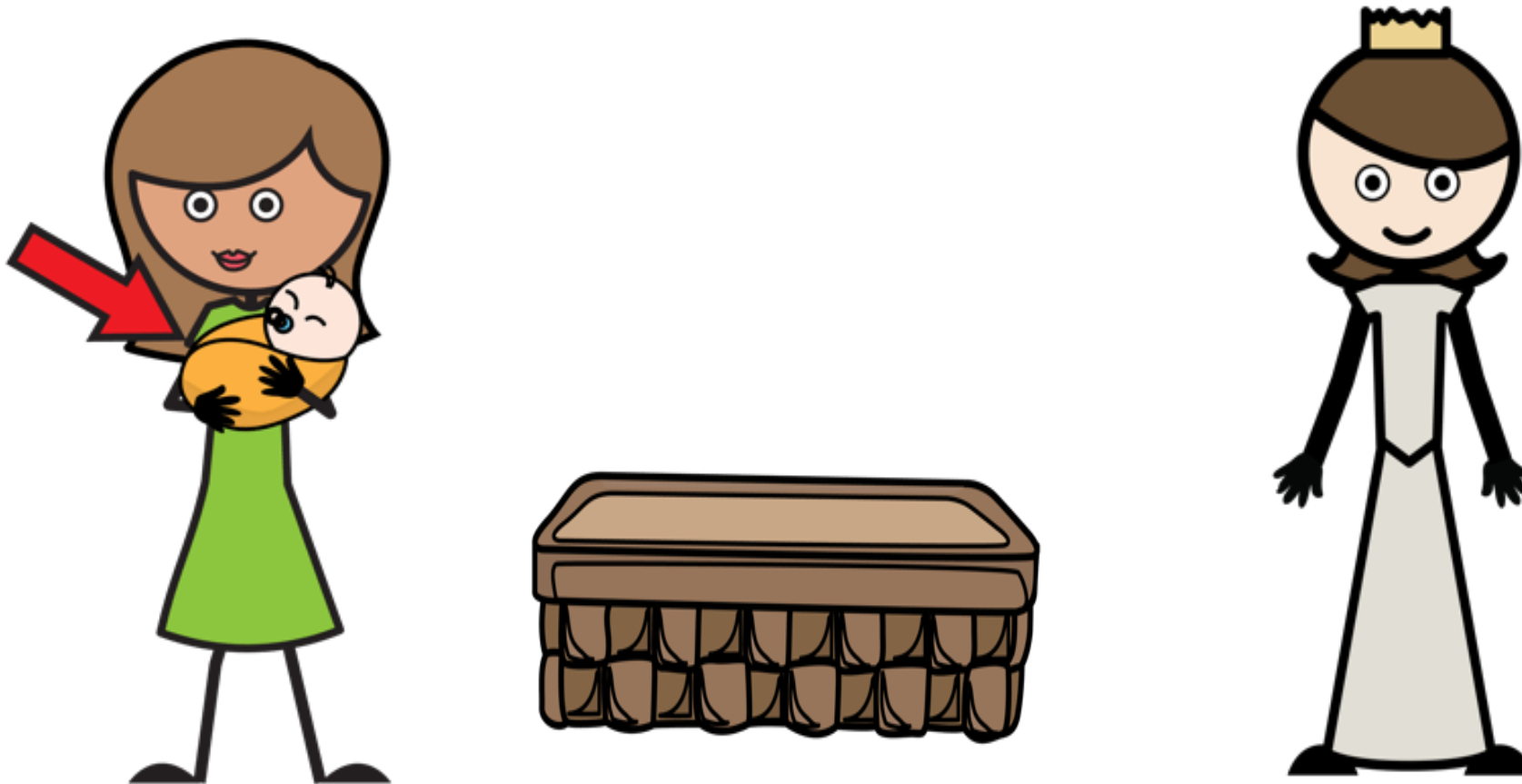
Jacob's family, now called the Israelites, had grown very large. This made Pharaoh scared.



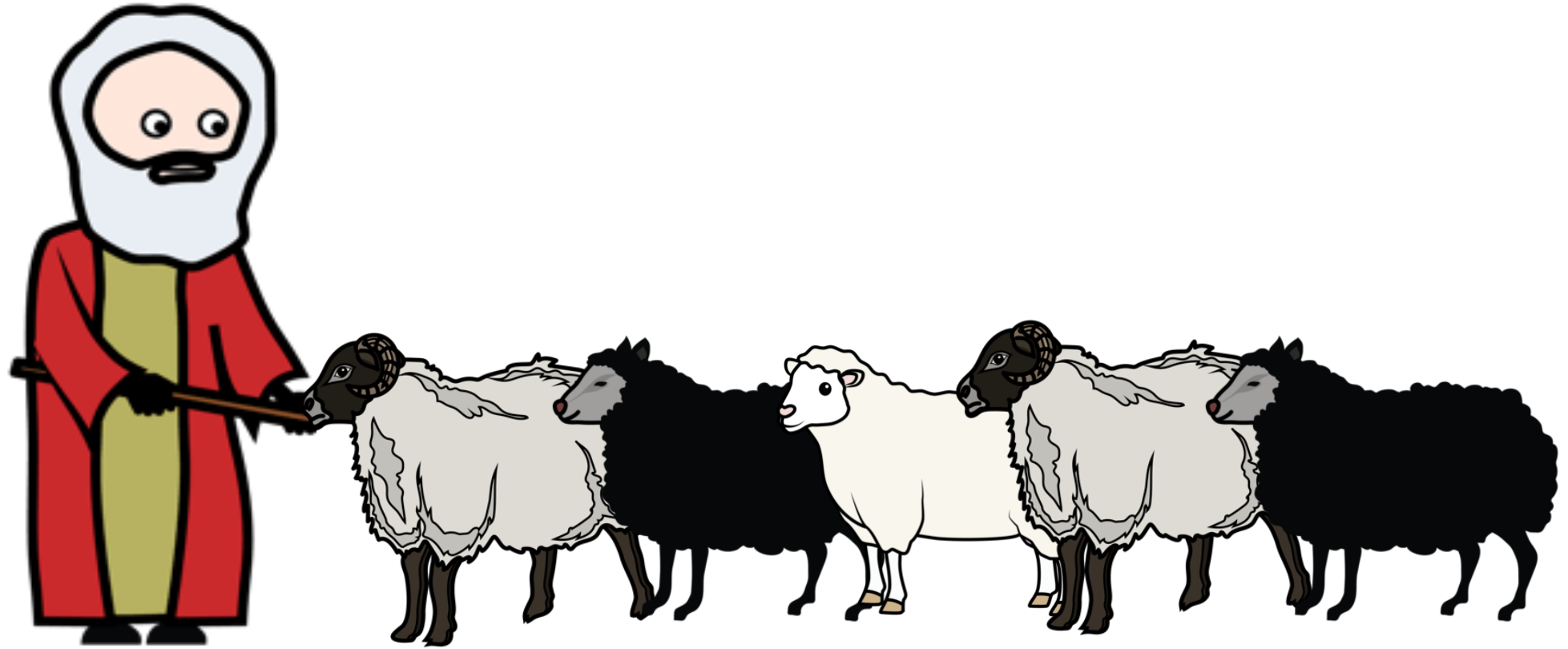
**Pharaoh made the Israelites his slaves.

After Moses grew up, he left Egypt and became a shepherd.



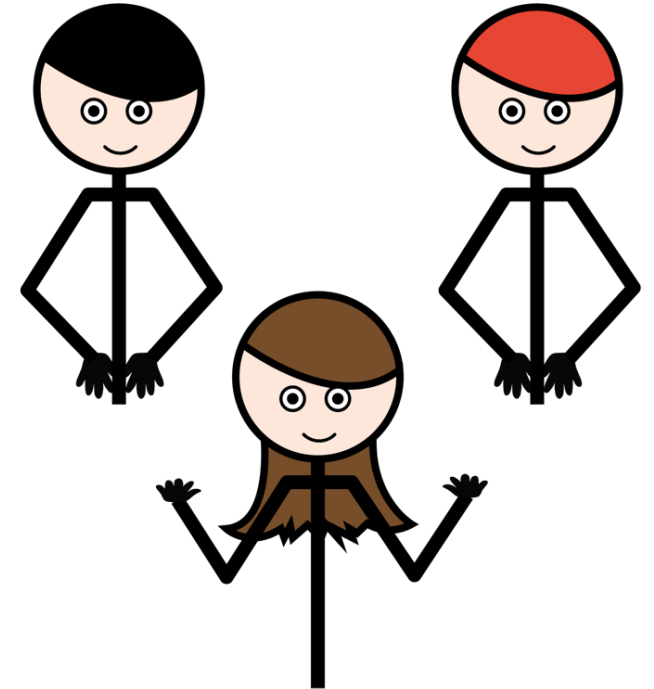
**Moses led his flock of sheep to a mountain.
