




This Week's Teaching Truth: We can be thankful for who God is




Jacob's family had grown incredibly large. This frightened Pharaoh, the king of Egypt.

Moses grew up but then became a shepherd.




Moses led his flock to a mountain. He saw a bush on fire that did not burn up.






God spoke to Moses from the bush and told him His rescue plan for His people. God wanted Moses to go help rescue them from slavery.




Moses was scared.
