





This week's Finish Line:

but God always keeps His promises!




King Ahab was a bad king of Israel. He did not worship God. He worshipped fake gods called idols.




The people were trying to worship both the idols and God.



God sent Elijah back to King Ahab. They would have a contest to prove that God was the true God and not the idols.




Elijah and the fake priests in charge of worshipping fake idols met on a mountain. The fake priests called on their god all day to burn up their sacrifice. Nothing happened.




Elijah asked them if their god was asleep or on a trip. They got no answer from their god.



Elijah built an altar with 12 stones. He poured water all over the altar and he prayed to God.




God sent fire from heaven that burned everything up: the sacrifice, the wood, the rocks, and even the water!






When the people saw this, they fell down and cried out, "The LORD - He is God!"
