

ELEMENTARY ACTIVITY GUIDE

WE BELIEVE: THE FUTURE

SCRIPTURE: John 14:1-6; Revelation 19:11-16;
Revelation 21:3-7

ACTIVITY 1: Illustrating the Future

SUPPLIES NEEDED: three pieces of paper and crayons or markers OR sidewalk chalk

DIRECTIONS: You can choose to do this inside or decorate your sidewalk to share what you learned with others. You will get to illustrate the answers to our three questions today. You can have each person illustrate all three answers OR you can choose three people and designate one answer for each of them to draw. Let your creativity run free and draw what you think it will look like when Jesus comes back, when He is the victorious King, and when God is with His people forever.

What is the most important thing about the future?

Jesus is coming back

What will Jesus do when He comes back?

He will fulfill prophecy, defeat His enemies, and rule forever

What happens to us in the future?

All people who have been saved through faith in Jesus will be with God forever

ACTIVITY 2: We Believe Review

SUPPLIES NEEDED: We Believe Truths PDF (can be found online in the Elementary Kit)

SET UP: It is important for everyone who has been saved through faith in Jesus to understand what the Bible tells us about the basic foundations of our faith. Some churches call these “catechisms” but we refer to them as our We Believe Truths. This year we have been teaching kids what we believe about the Bible, God, sin and salvation, the church, and the future. Find the “We Believe Truths” page in the list of resources in the Elementary Kit and use it to review the questions and answers for each of the five categories.

OPTIONS FOR REVIEW:

- Go over all the questions and answers today and then focus on one category each day during the week.
- Play Jeopardy style. Read the answers and see if your kids can tell you what question it is answering.
- Write the questions and answers out on separate notecards and have your kids try to match them.
- Read one of the verses listed and have your kids guess which category it is talking about.
