

PRESCHOOL DISCUSSION GUIDE

THIS WEEK'S STORY:

Jonah

UNIT: The Old Testament

UNIT MEMORY VERSE:

"Call to me and I will answer you, and I will tell you great and mighty things that you do not know."

JEREMIAH 33:3

TEACHING TRUTH:

God wants us to listen and obey

READ: Jonah 1 and 3

OPTIONAL: "God's Messenger" (pages 160-169) from The Jesus Storybook Bible

WHAT DOES IT SAY? (OBSERVATION)

- 1. What did God want Jonah to do? (He wanted Jonah to go tell the people of Nineveh that God would forgive them if they asked because He loved them.)
- 2. What happened when Jonah got on the boat? (There was a huge, scary storm.) What happened after Jonah was thrown overboard? (God stopped the storm and sent a big fish to swallow Jonah.)
- 3. What did Jonah do after the big fish spit him up? (Jonah obeyed and went to Nineveh to give them God's message.)

WHY DOES IT MATTER? (APPLICATION)

- 1. How do you think Jonah felt when he was in the belly of the fish? (Jonah was sorry for not obeying God and going to Nineveh right away like God told him to.)
- 2. What do you think God wants us to learn from this story? (Let your kids answer and then bring them back to this week's Teaching Truth: God wants us to listen and obey.)
- 3. Pray a short simple prayer thanking God that He loves us and wants us to listen and obey because He knows what is best.
