- \$BTC continues to trade within the \$92K–\$94K range. As of now, \$BTC is trading at \$93,470 and \$ETH is trading at \$1,772. Bitcoin dominance stands at 64.28%.
- This week's calendar includes earnings from major tech companies Microsoft, Amazon, Meta, and Apple the U.S. PCE report on Wednesday, and Token Dubai happening throughout the week.
- A few headlines from the weekend include: Term Finance lost about \$1.6 million worth of ETH on Saturday due to a misconfigured oracle; Loopscale lost \$5.8 million after an unknown attacker exploited an issue with one of its markets; and the U.S. SEC has approved ProShares Trust to launch multiple XRP-related futures ETFs.
- Over the last 24 hours, the top three gainers were \$PENGU, \$WAL, and \$XMR, while the top three losers were \$JST, \$ENS, and \$BSV.

Who is Kevin Warsh, and Why Does Trump Like Him?


Kevin Warsh, a former Federal Reserve governor and longtime critic of central bank overreach, delivered a major speech on Friday that has quickly reignited speculation over his future role in US monetary policy. President Trump, who has spent recent weeks criticising Jerome Powell for moving too slowly on rate cuts and hinting at his potential removal, appeared to walk back those threats last week. Yet the search for alternatives remains an open question, and Warsh's message may align closely with Trump's instincts.


In his remarks at the Group of Thirty, Warsh argued that the Fed's current credibility problems are largely "self-inflicted". He accused the central bank of abandoning its narrow mandate, pointing to its post-2008 asset purchase programmes, its subsidisation of deficit spending, and its forays into political issues such as climate change and social inclusion. Warsh warned that the Fed has become a "general-purpose agency" of government rather than an independent guardian of monetary policy.


At a time when Trump is seeking a Fed that prioritises low inflation, curbs the growth of federal deficits, and stays clear of progressive political causes, Warsh's call for a return to the discipline of the 1951 Fed-Treasury Accord could be particularly appealing. His emphasis on constitutional limits, institutional humility, and resisting political trends positions him as a candidate who would likely tighten the Fed's focus and resist mission creep. For a president critical of central bankers who "try to do too much and deliver too little," Warsh's worldview could offer a compelling alternative.












ORDER BOOK DEPTH (within 1% best bid/ask) Coinbase








