Permit Application Submittal Requirements

- Permit Submittals Submit Electronically to <u>dfwsubmittals@dfwairport.com</u>
- Permit Application completed with no blanks. Must have accurate brief description of project. If project is not a new building then a description of type of work being performed i.e.; electrical, mechanical, plumbing, etc. Must include Skire time code (for TRIP and Board projects). Accurate valuation (total value of work) is required at time of submittal.
- Plans Building construction plans including Mechanical, Electrical, and Plumbing with engineer's and/or architect's seal (as required by state law) –

The site plan must show the proposed work and its location in relation to property lines and existing buildings. Site plans must include the following:

- Specified scale, north arrow and legal description
- Existing and/or proposed structure(s) with exact dimensions
- Parking areas and required number of parking spaces
- Driveway locations and traffic circulation system
- Lot and building line dimensions, as well as dimensions from property line to the project
- Alley with dimensions, if applicable
- All easements, if applicable
- Street names
- Sidewalks
- Location of nearest fire hydrant(s)
- Fire lanes
- Utility or civil engineering site plan, showing water and sanitary sewer.
- Commissioning Plan approval Airport Board / Trip projects only as follows:
 All construction projects of any type valued over \$500,000. New buildings, remodels, and additions valued over \$50,000.
- TDLR for all building projects over \$50,000. Proof of project registration with TDLR and copy of TAS Plan review. Applicable to buildings, remodels, additions, parking. Not applicable to utilities only type projects.
- FAA Airspace for projects that affect the airport layout or airspace. Not applicable to interior type projects within existing buildings.
- Proof of project cost copy of contract documents showing cost
- Energy Code review sheet (Comcheck)
