Employee Parking and Public Transit:

Winter Weather Event, Jan. 22-27, 2026

Wintery weather is forecasted through Jan. 27. To support our badged DFW teams throughout the airport, we're opening four (4) "Employee Only" lanes – two (2) at the North Control Plaza and two (2) South Control Plaza. Employees who use public transit should also check service alerts before leaving.

Please see the details below and help ensure other team members have awareness.

What you need to know:

- Plaza entries by badged employees:
 - **First Entry:** Begins at **11:59 p.m., Thursday, Jan. 22.**
 - **Last Entry:** Must occur by **11:59 p.m., Monday, Jan. 26.**
 - **Employee Only Lanes:** Enter and exit using the "Employee Only" lanes.
 - Entry lanes are to the left and Exit lanes are to the right of the Plazas.
 - **Last Exit:** Must exit by **11:59 p.m., Tuesday, Jan. 27.**
- All employees that park in the employee lots may utilize the Terminal parking benefit. Employees **may exceed 24 hours** in the terminals **but must exit by 11:59 p.m., Tuesday, Jan. 27.**
- Employees should **avoid parking in Terminal C1 and C2 garages, Terminal D, and Terminal B1 garage**
- **Existing central terminal area parkers** should continue to use designated "Toll Tag" lanes.
 - These parkers will still need to exit and reenter the Plaza within a 24-hour period to ensure they are not charged.
