2.	. LP-gas containers shall be stored in proper cages, which shall be locked.					
3.	LP-gas storage areas shall be protected from vehicle impact.					
4.	LP-gas storage areas shall be separated from smoking areas by a minimum of 25 feet.					
5.	LP-gas containers in storage shall be located in a manner that minimizes exposure to excessive temperature rise, physical damage or tampering.					
6.	LP-gas containers in storage shall be position	oned with the pressure relief valve in direct communication with the vapor				
7.	LP-gas containers shall not be located within 10 feet of exit access doors, exits, stairways or in areas normally used,					
	intended to be used, as a means of egress I less than 5 feet.	N TERMINAL BUILDINGS. At other locations, this distance shall be no				
8.	LP-gas containers shall not be stored within	10 feet of combustible materials.

	12. LP-gas container valves shall be protected by screw-on type caps or collars which shall be securely in place on all containers stored regardless of whether they are full, partially full or empty. Container outlet valves shall be closed plugged.
