

Badge Identification Requirements

TSA regulations require badge applicants to provide unexpired documents that establish both identity and employment authorization.*
Below are examples of acceptable documents.

BADGE APPLICANTS MUST PRESENT:

(1) one selection from List A

OR

a combination of (1) one selection from List B **AND**
(1) one selection from List C

LIST A

Documents that establish both Identity & Employment Authorization

Please bring one of the following:

- U.S. Passport or Card



- Permanent Resident Card



- Foreign Passport with I-551 stamp or I-94



- Employment Authorization Document (I-766)



LIST B

Documents that establish Identity

Please bring one of the following:

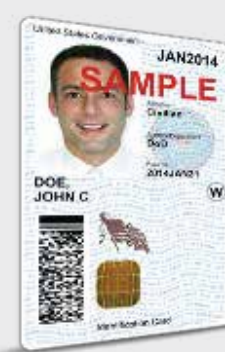
- State-issued Driver's license



- State-issued ID card



- Federal, State, or Local government-issued ID card



- U.S. Military card



LIST C

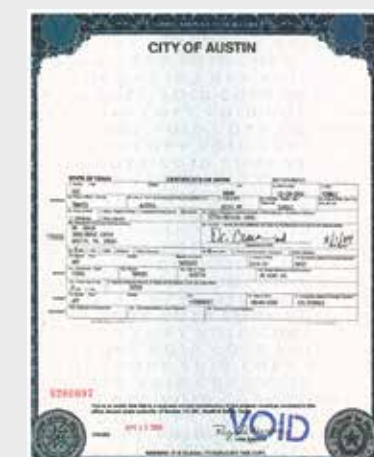
Documents that establish Employment Authorization

Please bring one of the following:

- U.S. Social Security card



- Certified birth certificate



- Certification of report of birth issued by the Department of State, Forms DS-1350, FS-545 or FS-240



***If you were born outside of the United States or the U.S. Territories:**
You must provide (1) one of the following:

- Consular Report of Birth Abroad or Certification of Report of Birth; or
- U.S. Passport, Permanent Resident Card, or other List A document; or
- List B document, List C document, and your Alien Registration Number (A#)

Badge Identification Requirements, Form I-9

TSA regulations require badge applicants to provide unexpired documents that establish both identity and employment authorization.*

BADGE APPLICANTS MUST PRESENT:

(1) one selection from List A

OR

*a combination of (1) one selection from List B **AND** (1) one selection from List C*

LIST A

Documents that establish both **Identity & Employment Authorization**

Please bring one of the following:

1. U.S. Passport or U.S. Passport card
2. Permanent Resident Card or Alien Registration Receipt Card (Form I-551)
3. Foreign Passport that contains a temporary I-551 stamp or temporary I-551 printed notation on a machine readable immigrant visa
4. Employment Authorization Document that contains a photograph (Form I-766)
5. For a non-immigrant alien authorized to work for a specific employer because of their status:
 - a. Foreign Passport; and
 - b. Form I-94 or Form I-94a that has the following:
 - (1) The same name as the passport; and
 - (2) An endorsement of the alien's non-immigrant status as long as that period of endorsement has not yet expired and the proposed employment is not in conflict with any restrictions or limitations identified on the form.
6. Passport from the Federated States of Micronesia (FSM) or the Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI) with Form I-94 or Form I-94a indicating non-immigrant admission under the Compact of Free Association between the United States and the FSM or RMI.

LIST B

Documents that establish **Identity**

Please bring one of the following:

1. Driver's license or ID card issued by a state or outlying possession of the U.S., provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, gender, height, eye color, and address
 2. ID card issued by federal, state or local government agencies or entities, provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, gender, height, eye color, and address
 3. School ID card with a photograph
 4. Voter's registration card
 5. U.S. Military card or draft record
 6. Military dependent's ID card
 7. U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Card
 8. Native American tribal document
 9. Driver's license issued by a Canadian government authority
- For persons under age 18 who are unable to present a document above:
1. School record or report card
 2. Clinic, doctor or hospital record
 3. Daycare or nursery school record

LIST C

Documents that establish **Employment Authorization**

Please bring one of the following:

1. Social Security Card, unless the card includes one of the following restrictions:
 - (1) NOT VALID FOR EMPLOYMENT
 - (2) VALID FOR WORK ONLY WITH INS AUTHORIZATION
 - (3) VALID FOR WORK ONLY WITH DHS AUTHORIZATION
2. Certification of report of birth issued by the Department of State (Forms DS-1350, FS-545, FS-240)
3. Original or certified copy of birth certificate issued by a state, county, municipal authority, or territory of the U.S. bearing an official seal
4. Native American tribal document
5. U.S. Citizen ID Card (Form I-197)
6. Identification card for use of Resident Citizen in the United States (Form I-179)
7. Employment Authorization Document issued by the Department of Homeland Security

***If you were born outside of the United States or the U.S. Territories:**
You must provide (1) one of the following:

- Consular Report of Birth Abroad or Certification of Report of Birth; or
- U.S. Passport, Permanent Resident Card, *or* other List A document; *or*
- List B document, List C document, and your Alien Registration Number (A#)
