Skill assessment

Students complete a Future Ready Skills Self Assessment and identify 2 strengths and 1 area for growth.



### **Hitting the Ground Running**

Preparing for success

After watching 3 short videos of former interns talking about their experiences, students reflect on what advice they can use to be better prepared for internships in the future.



### Plan It Like a Pro!

Project management

Students create a draft of a project plan for a fictional internship.



### What You Say & How You Say It

Verbal communication

Students choose between 3 scenarios and create a response for how they would communicate.



### **Put it in Writing!**

Written communication

Students have to draft a professional email to external clients based on information received from a fictional supervisor.

# **Enterprise Exploration**

Technology

Students research the products offered as part of Microsoft 365 and Google Workspace and create a table or an outline for a short presentation where they compare the two options' features for daily work (documents, spreadsheets, presentations), emails, and communication tools.



## **Making Every Minute Count**

Time management

Students have to map out how they would plan their week during an internship based on different meetings, tasks, and larger projects.



#### Get Social...IRL

Social capital building

Students come up with 3 different questions to start conversations with colleagues so that they can begin forming professional connections.



### The Art of Constructive Feedback

Giving & receiving feedback

After watching a video about how to give and receive feedback, students play the role of an internship supervisor having to give feedback to an intern who isn't completing tasks at the expected quality level.



# **Farewell but not Goodbye**

Maintaining positive relationships after ending an internship

Using thank you note templates for inspiration, students draft a thank you message they would send to their supervisor at the end of an internship and a short check-in message they would send six months afterwards.

### TRACKING STUDENTS' WORK

In KnoPro, you have the option of tracking students' completion of Skillbuilders and viewing what they submitted. To do so, you must create a free Educator account.
