

### ABOUT THIS ACTIVITY

Mock interviews allow students to practice their interviewing skills and get feedback from industry professionals. Students typically prepare and provide a resume to the interviewer. In addition to answering questions, students are encouraged to prepare questions to ask the interviewer.

Mock interviews can take place in-person, by phone, or virtually.

### BEFORE THE ACTIVITY

**Review list of common interview questions and choose ones you want to ask**

- Browse NAF's one-page [list of interview questions](#)
- Review any documents sent to you by the academy
- Add any questions you would like to ask

**Confirm logistics**

- Date/time/location
- If in-person: Parking instructions, check-in process
- If by phone: Share your contact number
- If virtual: Platform being used, log-in link

**Prepare information to share with the student**

- This could include details about your industry, company, and the education and/or training required

**Review assessment rubric (if provided)**

- The educator or other person coordinating the event may share a document to use for feedback

### DAY OF THE ACTIVITY

**In Person**

A student, educator, or staff member will meet you at the front desk and escort you to the room.

**Virtual**

You should receive the login link in advance.

**Phone**

You should receive a call from the student.

### AFTER THE ACTIVITY
