Player 1 chooses an element and Player 2 draws a relationship. For example, Player 1 chooses Water and Player 2 draws the relationship of Intern -> Intern's School

Discuss the dynamics of the relationship using the following prompts:

What about the chosen element connects well to the drawn relationship?


What about the chosen element doesn't fit with the drawn relationship?

What does this stakeholder relationship mean to you? Your company?

EXAMPLES

Water —> flowing; a relationship that is balanced and equal

Songbird → communicative; a relationship that has high levels of communication

Tree → peaceful; a relationship built upon mutual levels of respect

Fire → intense; a relationship that is high-energy

Squirrel \rightarrow Industrious; a relationship built upon hard work from all involved

Air → Adaptable; a relationship whose dynamic changes depending on the situation
