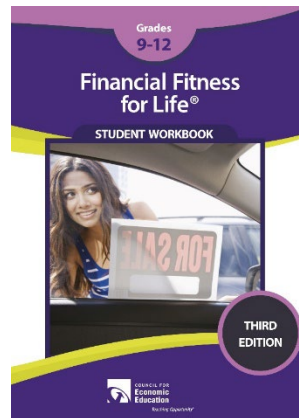
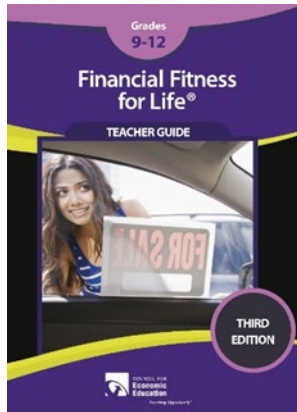


In this personal finance lesson, students will play a bingo game to learn about short and long term investments.
