

Use the guide for suggested course sequencing and pairing options to build the academy's program of study. You may also consider integrating other curricular options into the course sequencing, such as career-thematic Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, Cambridge, and Dual Enrollment courses.

Each NAF course is one semester. However, academies can pair courses to create a year-long class. The recommended course pairings (p.4) allow students the opportunity to build on knowledge from semester one to semester two.
