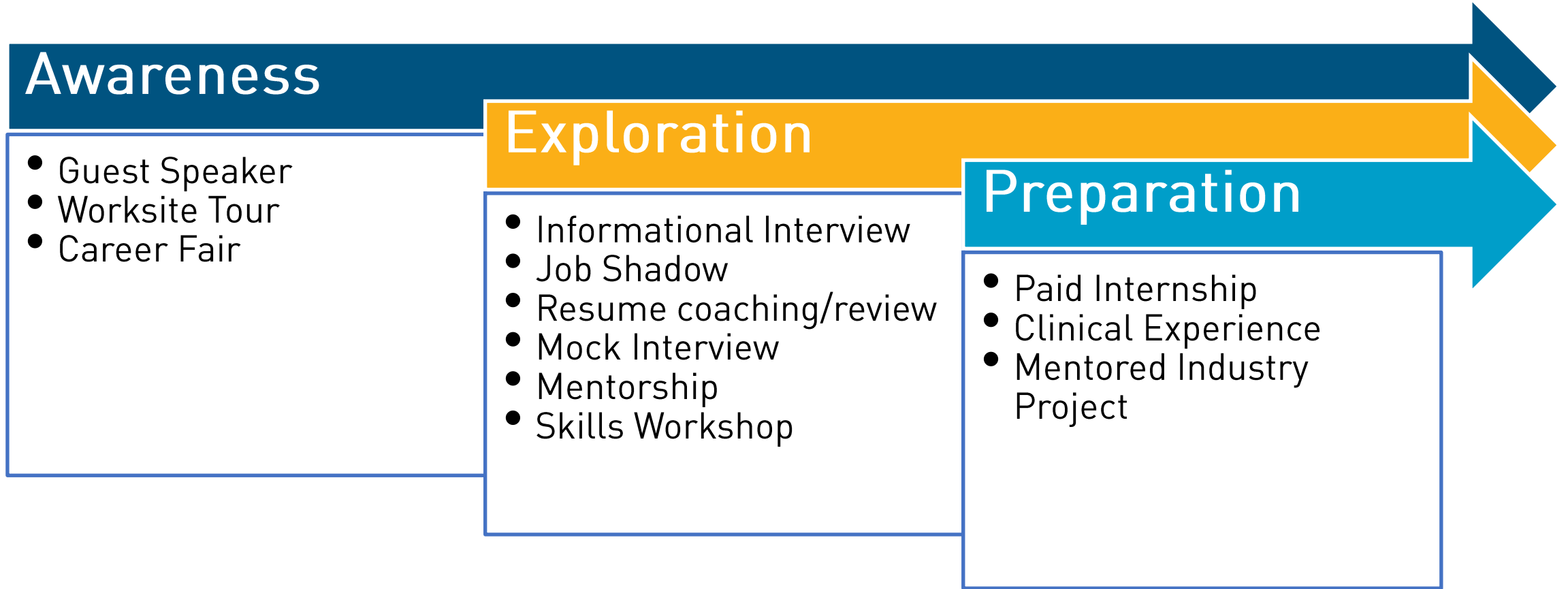

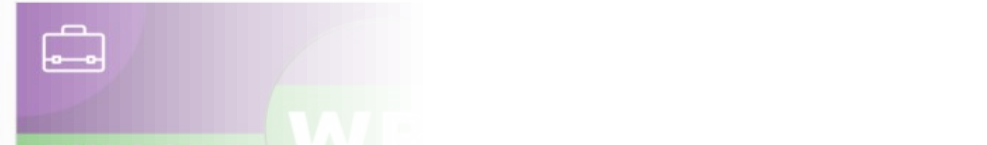

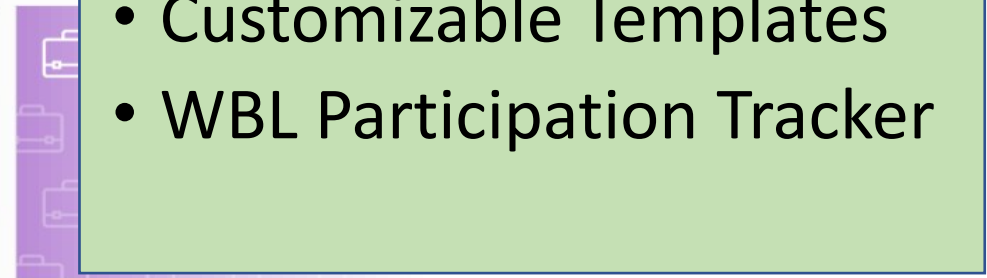
Prepare for Internships
