
### **SOURCE 2: PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATIONS**

- Contact the leadership of the chapter near you






# **EXAMPLE OF PROF. ASSOCIATION: SOCIETY OF HISPANIC PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS**





Through Interact clubs, people ages 12-18 connect with others in their community or school and learn about the world through service projects and activities.






### AN AMAZING WBL ACTIVITY TO ADD THIS YEAR

- Can be virtual or in-person







### **NAF WBL RESOURCES**
