NAF's Outcomes-Driven Work-Based Learning (ODWBL) model

Collecting data on work-based learning (WBL) is an essential part of being able to measure impact and assess equity. NAF has developed a suite of tools to help districts and educators plan and implement impactful, equitable work-based learning and easily share outcomes with all stakeholders.



WBL Participation Tracker and Reflection Form

The WBL Participation Tracker logs work-based learning activities and records student participation, while the WBL Reflection Form captures students' perceptions of each activity's impact.



Skills Feedback Survey and Future Ready Skills Assessment

The Skills Feedback Survey and the Future Ready Skills Assessment allow industry professionals a user-friendly way to give formalized feedback to students on the development of their future ready skills.
