3 Ways Work-Based Learning Impacts Students

NAF'S standards of quality work-based learning

Interaction

Students have ongoing interactions with professional in workplace settings through a variety of experiences.

Outcomes-Driven

Students discover careers of interest, make a plan to achieve their goals, develop professional skills and monitor their growth, and make meaningful connections with professionals.

Preparation & Reflection

Students prepare for each experience with guidance from their teacher and reflect on their experience after participation.

Classroom-Connected

Students develop career-ready skills by connecting classroom content with intentionally aligned student learning outcomes developed in collaboration with educators and partners.



WBL Criteria in Academy Assessment

4.1 Work-Based Learning Program

All academy students complete a sequence of work-based learning experiences that culminate with career preparation activities and NAFTrack Certification.


WBL Action Planning & Implementation Process

Engage Stakeholders

- Present Advisory Board Members and Industry Partners with student interests and needs
- Use the WBL Calendar to codify WBL plans
- Understand unique stakeholder skills and connections to student learning

Identify WBL Interest and Needs

- · Survey Student Interest
- · Analyze WBL Data
- · Identify WBL Gaps
- Understand WBL approach in aspirations, skills, and connections



Plan and Deliver WBL

- Finalize plans for WBL engagement through use of various NAF resources and tools
- Identify specific learning outcomes
- Identify tracking, impact, and reflection approaches to given engagement

Reflect and Codify Learning

- · Record student reflections on the experience
- Survey stakeholders for their perspective of the experience
- · Analyze learnings for future planning
- · Use learnings in Academy action planning
- Record experience as evidence of WBL for the Academy Assessment and continuous improvement cycle

- Activity information by location, types, month, theme/career cluster and geographic location



- Total # of students and hours
- Average # of hours/student
- % of students who participated in 1 or more activity (also shown by continuum phase)
- Activity information location & types
- Student information gender, ethnicity, graduation year, # of students/month, theme/career cluster and geographic location

Action Planning - Advisory Board Input

Employer partners can be a great resource for engaging WBL! The Advisory Board should help with event planning and connections

- Ask for Advisory Board Input on yearly plans
- Ask members to attend planned WBL events
- Can members or connections host an

event

Most boards plan for the School Year during a Summer retreat or early Fall meeting





Engagement Examples

- Advisory Board members: serve as mentors on student projects or judges for a competition
- Local company hosts a group of students for a tour and time to interact with employees
- A small group of students job-shadow a professional in their field of interest
- Business professionals lead an event focused on mock-interviewing for juniors and seniors



Schedule a meeting with your Portfolio Manager for overall Action Planning (including WBL)



Identify and pull together WBL data



Connect with Advisory Board members to coordinate reflection on 2022-23 WBL and planning for 2023-24
