## Academy Quality Process 2025-2026: What's New in the Academy Assessment?



Academy Assessment (AA) changes for 2025-2026 are minimal. Model and Distinguished quality level thresholds, AA evidence requirements and changes to a few strategic actions in the AA are outlined.

## **Model and Distinguished Thresholds**

Thresholds for Model and Distinguished academies will be the same as they were in 2024-2025.

See <u>Model and Distinguished Academy Thresholds</u> for detailed threshold descriptions and requirements for academies to become or maintain a Model or Distinguished quality level this year.

Important Note: An academy must have had at least 10 seniors in the prior school year to be eligible for a Model or Distinguished quality level, even if percentage thresholds have been met.

## **AA Evidence**

Academy Assessment evidence requirements are generally the same as they were in 2024-25, with minor adjustments highlighted for a few strategic actions in the next section.

Evidence requirements within <u>NAF's Academy Assessment</u> vary depending on the quality level an academy aspires to attain. Each strategic action indicates one of the following four evidence types:

- 1. **Automatically populated** automatically populated from annual data collection in ASH, WBL Tracker or NAFTrack
- 2. Required for All all academies completing the AA must submit evidence
- 3. Required for Model + academies striving for Model or Distinguished level must submit evidence
- 4. Optional evidence is optional to submit for all academies

In addition, academies have the option to use the AA *Notes feature* to submit evidence instead of uploading a document (when applicable).
