- Send your intern an invitation to connect on LinkedIn, if you are not already connected with them

Set a calendar reminder to send a follow-up LinkedIn message or email to your intern within the six weeks after the end of their internship to check in and see how they are doing

If you see any posts or events on LinkedIn that you think your intern might be interested in, send them to your intern in a LinkedIn message or email
