The NAF network receives ongoing support from a national team, including opportunities for professional development, networking, corporate partnerships, grants, and more. Academy stakeholders have exclusive access to an array of resources to develop high-quality career academies. NAF invests significantly in innovative research to track student performance and learning outcomes to enhance NAF's design and better prepare students for future success. The annual membership fee allows NAF to continue to invest in providing students with access and opportunity, though fees represent less than 10% of the cost of service delivery.
