**Self-Study** – Self-study courses are online, self-paced learning experiences that can be completed at your convenience. includes prerecorded video lectures, interviews, text, case studies, interactions, knowledge checks and assignments.

**Hybrid Online** – Hybrid Online courses are online synchronous and asynchronous, faculty-led learning experiences that last four weeks and encourage collaboration with classmates. Includes webinars, prerecorded lectures, text, discussion, and assignments.

Live – Live courses are offered in-person, at AAPL institutes, where attendees receive face-to-face instruction from expert faculty members and are an interactive and engaging experience.

### **CPE** Eligibility

To be eligible for the CPE Capstone, candidates must meet the following criteria:

- Be a licensed M.D. or D.O.
- Been an active AAPL member for at least one year.
- Have at least two cumulative years of healthcare
  leadership experience and significant
  managerial oversight as described in the Capstone
  leadership criteria. Candidates must attest to
  significant lessons learned, physician leadership
  position(s) and dates/time spent in each role(s).
- Be (or have been) board certified in a clinical specialty recognized by the ABMS or AOA, or an equivalent recognized board certification commission in the country in which they reside and are licensed to practice.
- Three years' experience in clinical practice beyond residency and fellowship training.
- Complete the Certified Physician Executive curriculum OR have a qualifying graduate management degree program. ( MBA, MMM, MHA, MPH, MS-HQSM, MS in management, etc.) and have completed 2 of the following 5 core courses:
  - Fundamentals of Physician Leadership Negotiation
  - Practical Principles of Change Management
  - Resolving Conflict
  - Managing Physician Performance
  - Transforming Healthcare through Quality Improvement
- Once you meet all eligibility requirements, you apply online for the CPE Capstone. There is a \$195 application fee. The Capstone is a 3 ½ day certifying program and is the final step in achieving the CPE credential. We offer the Capstone four times per year.

### **CPE Capstone**

The Capstone is the final required step in the certification program that will allow you to earn the CPE credential. There are three virtual Capstones and one held live in-person. Travel is required to attend the in-person Capstone.

This 3½-day program is designed to provide you with additional education based on the CPE competencies. Completing exercises in the general and cohort sessions will allow you to practice and hone your skills in preparation for your CPE Leadership Summary Presentation. This is completed and video-recorded on the final half-day.

The CPE Leadership Summary Presentation allows you to succinctly communicate how you have demonstrated your ability as a physician leader. This presentation will cover leadership philosophies, competencies, accomplishments and the ability to meet current and future challenges in healthcare.

#### Certification

The CCMM is a not for-profit corporation chartered by the American Association for Physician Leadership® to establish and maintain the highest standards for certification of physician executives.

The Capstone tuition is \$3,900 and is due 60 days before the event. Participants will be awarded 32 CME upon successful completion of the Capstone.

The American Association for Physician Leadership is accredited by the Accreditation Council of Continuing Medical Education to provide continuing medical education for physicians.

The American Association for Physician Leadership designates this enduring material for a maximum of 32 AMA PRA Category 1 Credit(s)™. Physicians should claim only the credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity.

**Course credits** are only eligible to be applied for CPE prerequisite credit for 5 years from the date of an online self-study course or the attendance date of a live or Hybrid Online course.

In the case a course is no longer offered or has a reduction in CME, other courses may be assigned or selected to fulfill that specific course credit total.
