They can be transported by air, water or migratory species across international borders, reaching regions where they have never been produced or used.

> Centrica monitors the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 on Persistent Organic Pollutants and UK S.I. 2007/3106 The Persistent Organic Pollutants Regulations 2007.

> At issue, and based on information provided by our suppliers, Centrica makes this Declaration that components, substances, processes and materials used or produced during the manufacture of our products, do not intentionally contain persistent organic pollutants. Nor does it exceed the limits defined for unintentional trace contaminants, and to the best of our knowledge, does not use any process equipment containing persistent organic pollutants.
