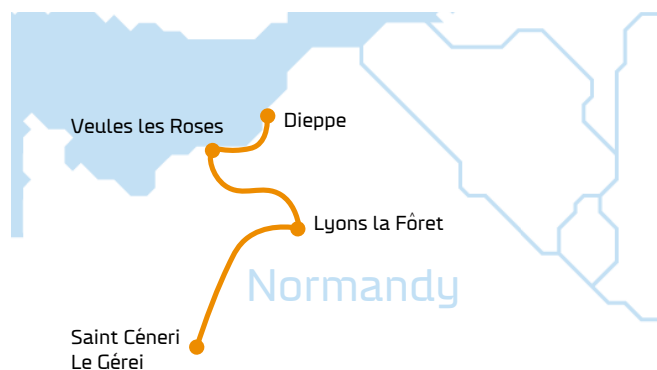
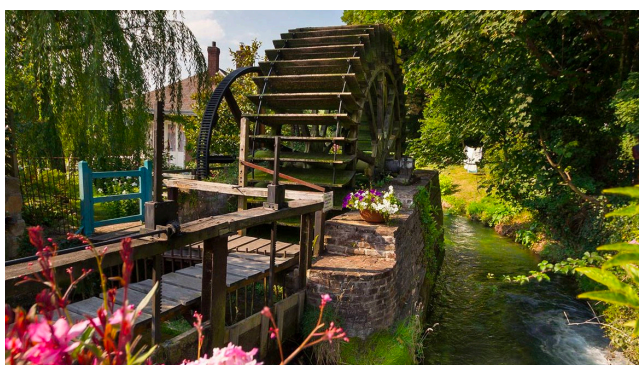


# MARKETS, MIRACLES AND MANICURED GARDENS



*Veules-les-Roses, Lyons-la-Forêt,  
Saint-Céneri-Le Gèrei*

- Visit **Veules-les-Roses** and stroll the paths peppered with sweet-smelling flowers.
- Explore the charming, chocolate-box town with thatched cottages, water mills and historic churches. Don't forget to try their famous oysters too!
- Browse the covered market at the medieval centre of **Lyons-la-Forêt** and pick up some produce for a picnic at your next stop.
- Marvel at the cathedral of beech trees in the forest of Lyons and do a spot of wildlife watching before enjoying your delectable, local food.
- Stop by the 18th century town hall to see its beautiful grand hanging baskets and striking ancient dungeons.
- Head south west to **Saint-Céneri-Le Gèrei** and visit the 15th century chapel of Saint-Céneri, where many miracles are said to have happened.



- As you cross the stone bridge into the village look out for an army shell protruding from the outside wall. This was placed there by American soldiers who mended the bridge following the liberation of the village in WW2.



- Walk to the summit of the Mont de Ava-loirs for far reaching views across the area.
