Schoorl - Zandvoort or Bloemendaal - Scheveningen - Zeeland

WHERE TO GO

- The nature reserve of the dunes of **Schoorl** in Noord-Holland is like no other place in The Netherlands. This reserve has some of the highest dunes in the country (some up to 55.4 metres) which stretch over 5km!
- **Zandvoort** is known for its beach but has so much more to offer! Browse the boutiques and taste some freshly caught fish in a seafront restaurant. Center Parcs' Park Zandvoort is located nearby with great accommodation options too. If you're looking for something more relaxed, head to **Bloemendaal** for trendy beach bars and a laid-back vibe!
- **The Scheveningen Pier** is known for its ferris wheel. Take a ride and spot some sea life from the top or head to The Hague nearby to explore Holland's centre of government.
- **The Zeeland province** is a great place to visit for people who love beaches and the sea. It has everything to offer from nature, to small villages, hiking tracks, fresh fish restaurants and much more! Stay at Center Parcs, Port Zélande for water-sports, outdoor adventures and much more!
