Dunkirk/Calais - Lille - Arras - Boulogne sur Mer

## WHERE TO GO:

- Head south to **Lille** and discover the Old Town's Flemish inspired architecture.
- See some art at the **Palais des Beaux-Arts**, do a spot of shopping at **Marché de Wazemmes**, one of France's largest outdoor markets and stop for a bite to eat in Lille's city square, taking in the cosmopolitan atmosphere.
- Drive west to **Arras** and visit the UNESCO listed Belfry at the City Hall with views across the city and beyond from 75 metres high!
- Delve into the history of Arras with a visit to **Carrière Wellington**, a system of tunnels which provided a hiding place for thousands of soldiers during WW1. Its 17th century citadel is also a UNESCO World Heritage Site and worth a visit.
- Don't forget to try **Cœurs d'Arras**, heart shaped gingerbread biscuits, for a sweet treat for your onward journey.
- Stop at **Boulogne-sur-Mer**, a charming seaside town less than an hour from both our ports. Try some freshly caught seafood, visit the largest medieval crypt in Northern Europe, and meet some friendly fish at **Nausicaa**, Europe's largest aquarium!
