TRADITION, HISTORY AND STUNNING LANDSCAPES



Le Bec-Hellouin, Beuvron-en-Auge & Barfleur

- Drive south from Dieppe to Le Bec-Hellouin and stroll the cobbled streets with historic half-timbered houses.
- Visit the medieval Abbey of Notre Dame where a community of Benedictine monks still reside and produce hand-made pottery which you can buy as a memento of your trip.
- Head west to Beuvron-en-Auge. Stop by Auberge de la Boule d'Or, an 18th century former inn or step further back in time at the 16th century village square.
- Walk through a centuries old beech forest to the 12th century Saint-Michel chapel of Clermont-en-Auge. Be prepared for breathtaking views over the Dives valley and forests of the Orne.
- In Barfleur, climb the Lighthouse of Gatteville, the second highest lighthouse in Europe and see for miles.





 Visit the weekly Saturday market in Barfleur for a range of local produce, and an abundance of freshly caught fish!



 Delight your eyes and ears on a boat trip to Tatihou island, a bird's paradise and ornithological reserve, with scores of species of birds to spot.

What to pack:
