Towards a greener DFDS

DFDS provides a major European shipping and logistics network to customers who benefit from a continuously growing range of transport services. At DFDS we are aware that our business activities have an impact on the environment and therefore we are constantly searching for innovative and intelligent ways to develop DFDS in a greener direction. It is our policy to consider the environmental impact of everything we do, with resulting actions from further reduction in ships' and lorries' fuel consumption to lowering noise levels at terminals and minimizing our electricity consumption.

Our people are the main driving force

Local initiatives and employees are the primary driving forces behind our work on the environment. Our goal is that the entire DFDS organisation should embrace our environmental policy through securing continuous improvement and sharing best practices in accordance with THE DFDS WAY of working. We have our own environmental staff who assist fellow employees in their environmental work, in every way possible.

What does DFDS do?

Our actions to develop DFDS in a greener direction are continuously reviewed and include the following:

- We collect, monitor and measure environmental data from all of our activities in order to determine our status with regard to environmental protection.
- We establish ambitious CO₂ reduction targets for our maritime and land-based activities. We continue to minimize our waste and optimize our waste-handling at all facilities and on all vessels.
- We ensure that disposal of assets for recycling is done in a sustainable manner.
- We cooperate with wider society to reduce emissions from our vessels further, to limits below the legal requirements.
- We take a partnership approach and continuously come up with innovative ways of solving logistical challenges in an environmentally sound way.
- We implement "good neighbour" policies, respecting local environments and populations.
- Our procurement policy prescribes minimum environmental standards for our suppliers.
- We communicate openly about our environmental footprint and ongoing plans to reduce our impact.
- We set and communicate individual targets for our activities and their environmental impact.
