## WHERE TO GO:

- Before heading west from Dieppe, visit its Saturday morning market, voted **'France's Finest Market 2020.'**
- Explore the stunning Alabaster Coast and gorgeous gardens of **Varengeville-sur-Mer.**
- Visit one of the most beautiful villages in France, **Veules-les-Rose**, famous for its river, flower gardens and for being the home of Victor Hugo, the mind behind the epic story *Les Misérables*.
- For the cyclists among you, a visit to **L'Avenue Verte**, the 470km cycle route between London and Paris, is a must.
- Stroll the cobbled streets of **La Bouille**, the land of impressionism, to see medieval merchants' houses, grand 19th century chateaux and art galleries which house works influenced by this area.
- Known as 'the village of a thousand rose bushes' the colours, scents and sights of **Gerberoy** will delight you long after you've left. Wander the beautifully manicured gardens in the ruins of a 19th century castle created by artist Le Sidaner and breathe in this haven of peace.
- Try some watersports at **Le Tréport**, explore the varied flora and fauna at **Sainte-Croix** and walk along the belle-époque esplanade of **Mers-les-Bains**.
