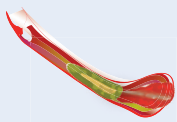




Stroke and recovery

There are **two types** of stroke:



Ischaemic strokes:
when a blood vessel
is blocked.

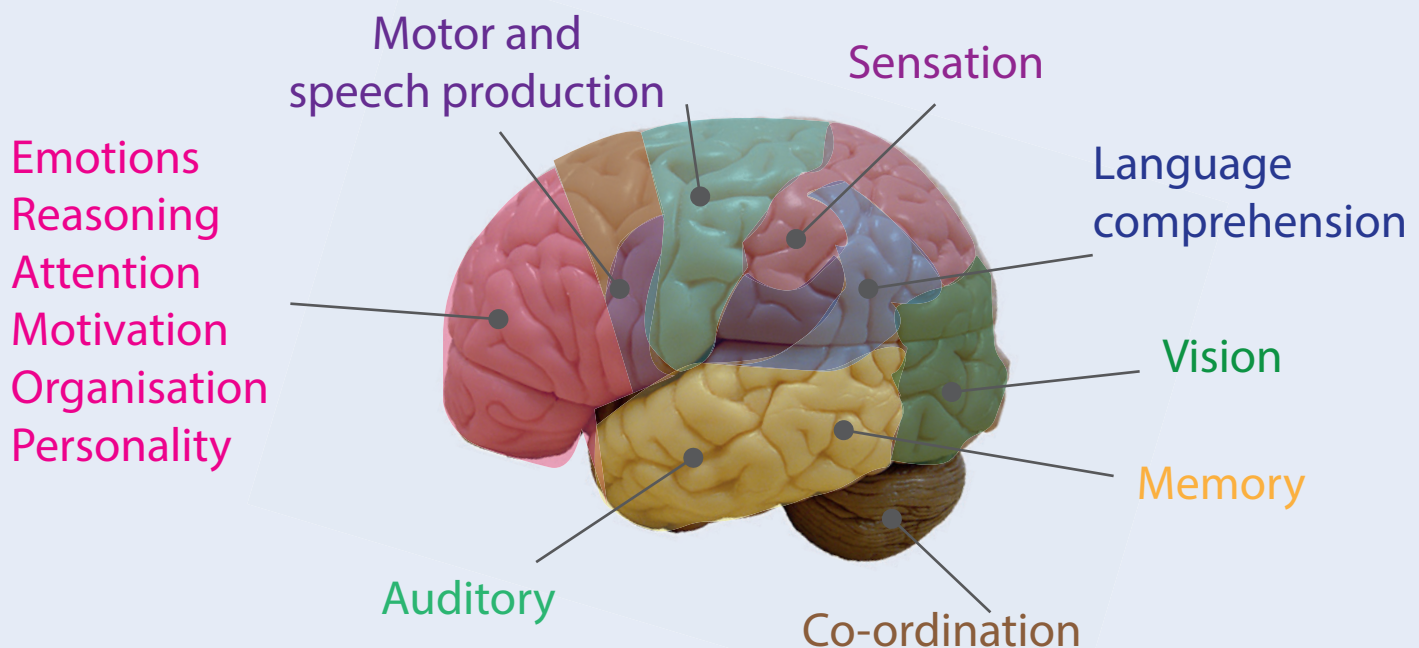


Haemorrhagic stroke:
when a blood vessel
leaks into the brain.



A **CT** or **MRI scan** can show the location
and type of the stroke.

Different skills are **affected** depending on the **location** of the stroke.
Strokes that affect **language** are usually in the **left side of the brain**

Recovery from stroke takes time.



Everyone's brain everyone's stroke and everyone's recovery pattern is different



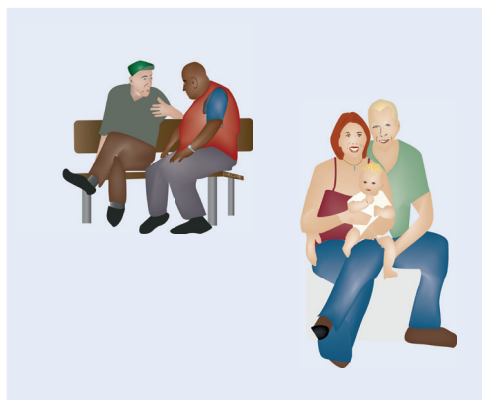
Recovery from stroke often takes lots of small steps forward.
