



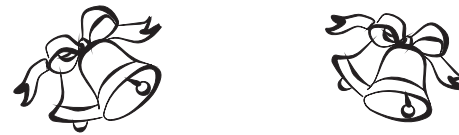
## Wise Men & Camels

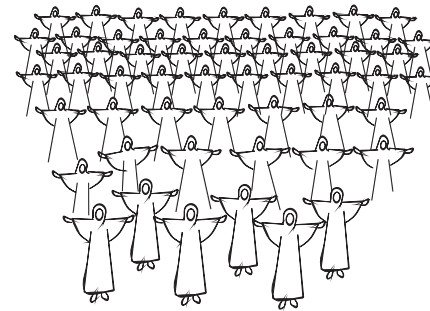
