- Is anything considered investigative? If so, how much will it cost me?

- How long of a hospital stay is covered by my policy after the delivery of my baby?
- Does my policy cover a private room or suite, or will I have to share a room?
- Are nontraditional deliveries, like a home birth with a midwife, covered by my policy?

Questions to Ask Your Medical Provider (i.e, the Hospital)

- · What is the estimated total amount for labor and delivery expenses?
- Does the hospital have in-network specialists?
- Is there a maternity package?
