PURPOSE OF THE ROLE

The Steam Operator operates the MOTAT Pumphouse and other steam engines and boilers around the MOTAT sites, with a goal of demonstrating steam technology and bringing it to life in a way that will excite and entertain MOTAT visitors. The Steam Operator is also required to ensure that boilers and associated equipment are appropriately maintained for this safe use.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Demonstrate the workings of the MOTAT Pumphouse, including the Beam Engine.
- Actively engage with the Museum visitors through the operation of the Pumphouse and to provide a highquality customer experience at MOTAT.
- Operate small stationary engines around the MOTAT sites, as requested by the Technology in Action Manager.
- Ensure that the Pumphouse, Beam Engine and other steam engines are maintained in a safe and orderly condition and run to the specified schedule, as agreed with the Technology in Action Manager.
- Actively support the delivery of the MOTAT experience by providing relevant historical information about the objects being operated.
- Maintain relevant information on current exhibitions, upcoming events, and promotions.
- Regularly update the Technology in Action Manager/Coordinator with status of consumables and any issues that are likely to impact operations.
- Ensure all procedures, processes and documentation pertaining to Pumphouse and steam operations are adhered to and completed correctly and in an efficient manner.
- Ensure all safety inspections are undertaken prior to operations.
- Remain current on all emergency procedures in accordance with the overall Museum Emergency Response policies and procedures, including emergency telephone use.
- Embrace a mindset of continuous improvement in understanding and implementing the principles of Te Tiriti o Waitangi.
- Model behaviours consistent with MOTAT values.
- Comply with all museum policies and procedures including but not limited to Health & Safety and the Museums Aotearoa's Code of Ethics.

• Undertake any other reasonable duties as may be required from time-to-time to ensure that MOTAT's business objectives are met.
