- 1. **Active Supervision:** Stay engaged with the students in your group, ensuring their safety and appropriate behavior at all times. Please avoid distractions, such as mobile phones, that might divert your attention.
- Guidance and Support: Encourage the students to ask questions, explore the exhibits, and participate in activities. Your enthusiasm will greatly enhance their learning experience.
- 3. **Group Management:** Keep track of the students in your care and ensure that they stay together as a group, particularly during transitions between activities, and when students need to use the bathrooms.
- 4. **Safety First:** Be aware of your surroundings and promptly address any potential safety concerns.
- Respect for the Venue: Remind the students to treat the exhibitions, staff and other visitors with care and respect. Your leadership will set the tone for their behavior.
