## What you will need



Board game cut-out



Large piece of cardboard



Ruler



Scissors



PVA glue / glue stick



Coloured paints



Paint brushes



Bottle tops



Dice



Printer

# Instructions

1. Print the 2 sides of the game onto A4 paper. There will be an overlapping middle section. Use this to glue one side to the other.



2. With a ruler, measure the height and length of the printed game. Draw the board outline onto the large piece of cardboard.



3. Using your glue, carefully stick the board game sheets onto the large piece of cardboard.



4. Choose a colour to paint the bottom of the board and place the board to one side to allow to dry.  
*Please dispose of paint responsibly\**



5. Collect bottle caps or buttons to use as counters. If they are all a similar colour you can paint them.




6. To make the dice, cut the net out and glue each flap to the corresponding face, creating a cube.
