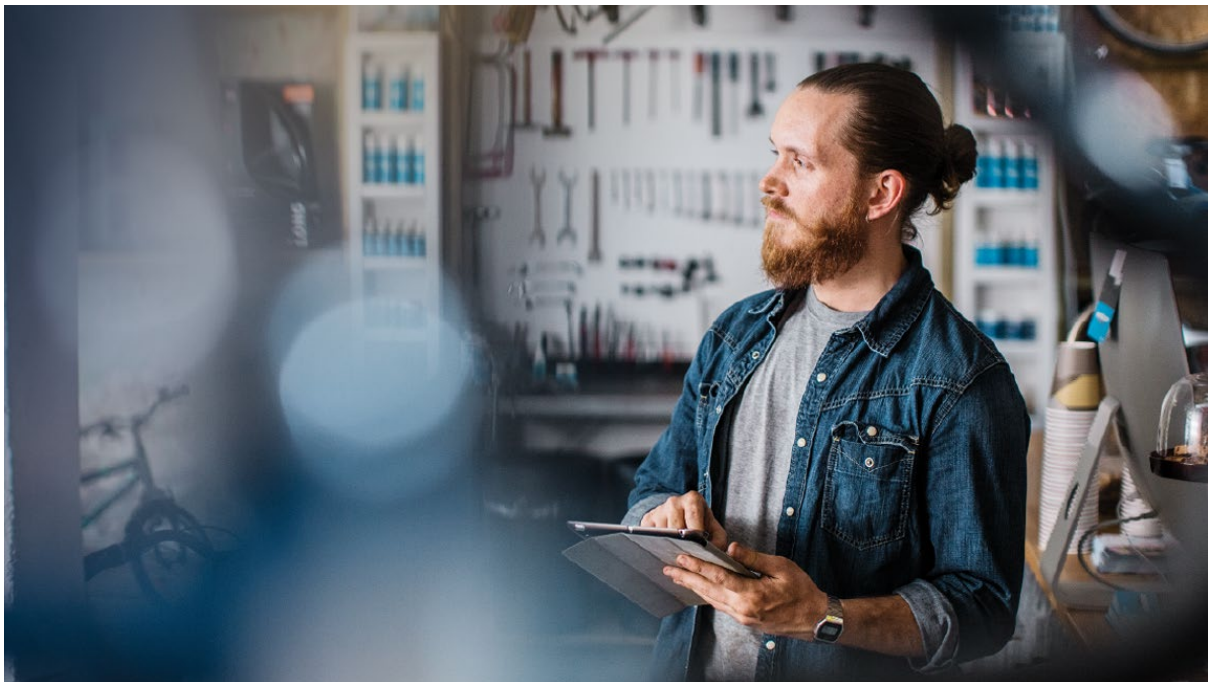

1. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this release is to introduce the new Move/3500 GPRS terminal with 2G/3G/4G functionality, along with the correction of a reboot issue in all Tetra terminals. A new terminal language and a temporary solution to a known issue in standalone terminals is also described.

The software release version is 07.0.2 and the test version is 70.34.

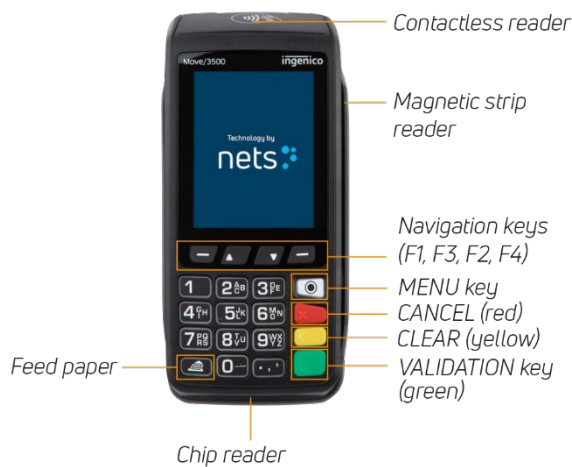
2. NEW FEATURES

2.1 New Functionality

The following sub-sections detail the new payment terminal introduced in this release.

2.1.1 Move/3500 GPRS with 2G/3G/4G

Move/3500 is ready for piloting as the Nets premium mobile terminal. It is the successor to both iWL250G/3G and iWL250B. This patch includes GPRS capability with 2G/3G/4G and allows this model to provide all-in-one communication options.



NB: The new test terminals are delivered without a 90-day expiry date.

Move/3500 has been configured for popular tourist cards such as Discover, Diners Club, JCB and Union Pay. For functionality, it will be possible to control this terminal remotely using the Nets Paypoint application. Move/3500 is not fitted with a PIN shield, therefore it must be handheld and used in a portable environment only. Move/3500 must not be fixed or used as a countertop.

2.2 Terminal Languages

French language support is added in this release. The Tetra terminals are now available in the following languages.

3. FIXED BUGS

The Tetra terminals were found to reboot in some scenarios i.e. the terminal reboots when simultaneous action is taking place on both the terminal and the ECR. An SDK fix is included in this release.

4. KNOWN ISSUES

When entering an amount into an idle standalone terminal, some number keys do not function. To avoid initiating incorrect transactions by entering a wrong amount, the numeric keys are blocked when a Tetra terminal stands in idle mode. However, the amount entry can be initiated on an idle screen by pressing the "OK" button or by choosing Purchase from the main menu. This is a temporary solution until the issue is resolved.

NB: The text "Test Terminal" appears on screen whenever a Tetra terminal is in idle/approve mode.

5. INTEGRATION

5.1 Connection Methods

NB: For RS232 integration, a minimum baud rate of 57600 is required. Bluetooth connectivity might be limited by third party hardware; Nets cannot confirm support for all phones and tablets.

Baxi.ActiveX is not supported on this range of terminals.

If using host communication via an ECR, the *use2buffer* option on Baxi must be enabled. In forthcoming versions of Baxi, this setting will be made obsolete, but current versions will require that this option is enabled.
