HOW TO SUCCEED IN HIGH SCHOOL	
<p>July 8-12 July 29 August 2 or August 19-23 <i>Bernardsville: 9:00-11:30 Monday-Friday</i> <i>Fanwood: 1:00-3:30 Monday-Friday</i></p> <p>Does your student enjoy learning but have difficulties staying organized? Are you concerned about managing the workload for high school? If your child wants to get a step ahead and learn how to set goals, this course will help him or her. We discuss active listening, note-taking, and critical thinking. We cover how to apply these skills to a variety of subjects--from math to English--and how to stay organized using technology. This class is geared towards students who struggle with executive functioning skills and rising high schoolers who want to get a leg up. Students will complete self-assessment exercises about their learning styles, time management, and study habits to gauge how they learn best and where they may need to improve.</p>
