10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. **11** Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. **12** For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.

The Armor of God

13 Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. 14 Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, **15** and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. 16 In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. 17 Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

18 And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people. **19** Pray also for me, that whenever I speak, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel, **20** for which I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I may declare it fearlessly, as I should.

Take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God

Rhema: to speak - a spoken word, made "by the living voice. Rhema is commonly used in the NT for the Lord speaking His dynamic, living word in a believer to in birth faith ("His persuasion")

 Rhéma (from rhéō, "to speak"). Ro 10:17: "So faith proceeds from (spiritual) hearing; moreover, this hearing (is consummated) through a rhēma-word from Christ."

Take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God

Logos: speaking to a conclusion – a word, being the expression of a thought; a saying. Logos is preeminently used of Christ (Jn 1:1), expressing the thoughts of the Father through the Spirit.

 Lógos is a common term (used 330 times in the NT) with regards to a person sharing a message (discourse,

"communication-speech") broad term meaning "*reasoning* expressed by *words*."

Laleó: to utter a voice - emit a sound: of things inanimate, "thunder uttered its particular voice"

• In the NT it is a more dignified word to speak. God speaks through us (the object)

Take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God

17 and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word (Rhēma) of God, 18 praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints, 19 and also for me, that words (logos) may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel, 20 for which I am an ambassador in chains, that I may declare it boldly, as I ought to speak (Laleó).

Keep each other's spirits up so that no one falls behind or drops out.
