It is a pleasure to be serving as your President for 2024-25. As I reflect on the first two months of the new Board, I am incredibly pleased with the inroads we have been able to make on issues of significance to students, and the growth that the current Board and executive has undergone. Over the next year, and indeed well after I am gone, as part of our strategy refresh, the USU will be committed to:

- 1. Becoming a more sustainable organisation beyond SSAF;
