
NOMINATIONS TO OPEN FOR ELECTION TO THE USU BOARD

 - This Board election will likely be for <u>4 candidates</u>, as opposed to <u>6</u>
 candidates
 - We cannot wait until next year (5 to 3 is unfeasible)

- Key changes
 - Campaigning now starts on Saturday May 3rd (Honi embargo issue)
 - 8.8.14(g): Increased **penalties for misinformation**
 - 8.2.7 (NEW) and Statutory Declaration: Board Charter embedded into election process
 - 8.5.3: Market pricing provision calibrated for the use of discounts
 - 8.8.6: **Verbal communication must be in English** when reasonable, such as pre-recorded content and official interviews, but not one-on-one or small group conversations
 - 8.8.31: A person must not hand out non-USU material when wearing a USU shirt
