The USU's commitment to hosting live music on campus has seen 95 events held at Manning Bar this year. One of those events, the inaugural Someday Soon music festival, saw over 2,600 attendees enjoy 25 acts across three stages at Manning House. Some of the USU's headliners this year include King Stingray, Middle Kids, Rema, and Ruby Fields, and we've been fortunate to host a stellar array of local and student performers. To continue this, we're investing in Manning Bar – this year, we've updated the seating and lighting, and for 2023, the Board has approved almost a quarter million dollars of members' funds to upgrade the audiovisual equipment.

The privacy and security of our members' personal information is a priority for the USU. Our systems have security controls, firewalls, and endpoint protection. There's regular penetrative testing, and a cybersecurity partner scans our network for unusual or dangerous processes. To minimise harm, we store limited personal data and are progressively updating our systems. As part of this, to streamline club administration, and better engage our members, the USU is developing a new cloud-based website, which will be launched in 2023.
