Milan beats New York: Bosco Verticale is the best skyscraper on Earth

During yesterday night, in Chicago, the Council on Tall Buildings and Urban Habitat promoted by Illinois Institute of Technology of Chicago, has awarded Bosco Verticale as the most beautiful and innovative skyscraper of the world, beating the One World Trade Center of New York, symbol of the American renaissance

Chicago, November 2015: After the International Highrise Award of Frankfurt and the success in China, the Bosco Verticale, designed and planned by **Boeri Studio** (Stefano Boeri, Gianandrea Barreca, and Giovanni La Varra) **managed by COIMA SGR**, in the district **Porta Nuova Isola in Milan**, has been awarded in USA as the **most beautiful and innovative skyscraper of the world**.

The prestigious Council on Tall Buildings and Urban Habitat promoted by Illinois Institute of Technology of Chicago chooses every year the best skyscraper in each continent and then declares the most beautiful and innovative one among all the continental winners. Bosco Verticale, after winning the award for the best European skyscraper, prize announced months ago, yesterday evening has won the award for the **Best Tall Building Worldwide 2015** giving to European architecture the victory over the other continents (the award has been won last year by the One Central Park in Sidney – Australia).

The prize giving took place in the night of 12th of November in Chicago during the ceremony in the famous Crown Hall designed by Mies van der Rohe. Bosco Verticale has won this prestigious prize competing against the One World Trade Center - New York, realized by the renowned SOM studio (CTBUH award winner for Americas) and the

favourite one for the worldwide prize, CapitaGreen – Singapore, realized by Toyo Ito & Associates Architects (CTBUH award winner for Asia - Ausatralasia), Burj Mohammed Bin Rashid Tower - Abu Dhabi, realized by Norman Foster + Parters (CTBUH award winner for Middle East & Africa).

The prize was awarded because Bosco Verticale is an unprecedented idea in its deployment of greenery at such scale and height. The building's intensive "*living façade*", incorporating numerous trees and more than 90 species of vegetation, is an active interface to the surrounding environment. The scheme is exceptional because of the plants act as an extension of the tower's exterior envelope. The jury called this exploration of the viability of greenery at such heights groundbreaking.
